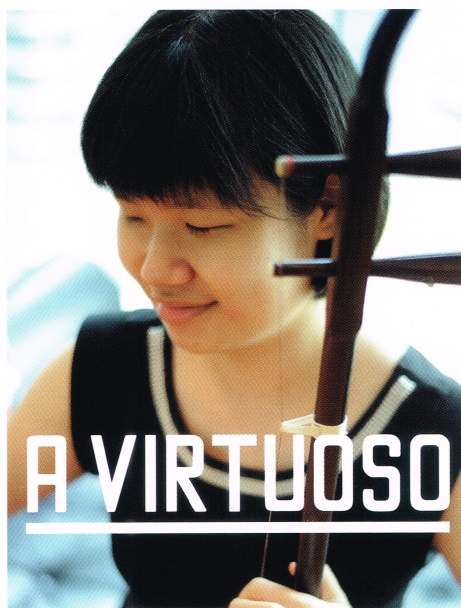
*Born to Be* is Deutsche Bank's youth engagement programme. We collaborate with charity partners, community leaders, governments and Deutsche Bank employee volunteers across Asia to support programmes that will help underprivileged young people fulfil their potential.

This year, as part of *Born to Be* in Singapore, we have expanded our partnership with the Singapore Chinese Orchestra (SCO) to establish:

- *The Deutsche Bank-Singapore Chinese Orchestra Music Scholarship*: Created for talented music students with disabilities, the scholarship is for recipients recommended by the SCO. The orchestra conducts outreach music programmes both to create an appreciation of music, and to identify and nurture young talent.
- *The Deutsche Bank-Singapore Chinese Orchestra Music Programme*: Designed for children with special needs, this collaborative programme aims not only to develop the musical capabilities of the students, but more importantly to inspire them to increase their levels of social interaction and thereby give them confidence.

Together, we're going to improve the lives of young people in Singapore so that they can have every chance to become who they were born to be.

### Stephanie Ow

Eighteen-year-old Stephanie Ow may be visually impaired but she has never let this stand in the way of her passion for the *erhu* (a two-stringed bowed musical instrument sometimes known as the "Chinese violin"). She wants to be a professional musician some day. *The Deutsche Bank-Singapore Chinese Orchestra Music Scholarship* has been awarded to Stephanie in recognition of her talent and her drive. The three-year programme will enable members of the SCO to nurture her artistic talent and help her realise her dream.

### Pathlight School Percussionists

Pathlight School is the first autism-focused school in Singapore that offers the mainstream academic curriculum together with life readiness skills. It primarily serves children with autism, aged 7 to 18 years old, who are cognitively able to access mainstream academics. Established in 2004 with just 41 students, today it has more than 900 students and has become one of the fastest-growing progressive special schools in Singapore. The school's percussion group has been under the weekly tutelage of SCO musician Ngoh Kheng Seng since March as part of *The Deutsche Bank-Singapore Chinese Orchestra Music Programme*. Our aim is to use music to inspire and help develop the musical capabilities of the students, as well as encourage social interaction, facilitate creative self-expression and stimulate emotional satisfaction.
