新加坡华乐团 Singapore Chinese Orchestra

新加坡华乐团是本地的旗舰艺术团体, 更是唯一的专业国家级华乐团。自1997年 首演以来,拥有超过80名音乐家的新加坡 华乐团在肩负起传统文化的传承之际,也 以发展和创新为重任。新加坡华乐团赞助 人为李显龙总理,并坐落于被列为国家古 迹的新加坡大会堂。新加坡华乐团更通 过汲取周边国家独特的南洋文化,发展成 具多元文化特色的乐团。各种资源和优势 相互交融,使新加坡华乐团成长为一支风 格独具的优质华乐团。

新加坡华乐团不断策划与制作素质高又多 元性的节目, 使它在华乐界占有一席之地, 而日益扩大的观众群也目睹了华乐团这几 年来的成长。2002年的滨海艺术中心开幕 艺术节上,新加坡华乐团带给观众一部富 于梦幻色彩, 又具真实历史事迹的交响幻 想史诗《马可波罗与卜鲁罕公主》,为乐团 发展史开创新的里程碑。2003年的新加 坡艺术节,新加坡华乐团与本地多元艺 术家陈瑞献一同呈献了别开生面的音乐 会《千年一瞬》,突破了单一艺术呈献的音乐 会形式。2004年新加坡建国39年,新加坡 华乐团召集了2400名表演者,以有史以来 最庞大的华乐队演出《全民共乐》, 堪称壮 举。2005年, 为纪念郑和下西洋600周年, 新加坡华乐团集合多方力量, 邀请多位国 际知名歌唱家同台演出音乐剧史诗《海上 第一人 — 郑和》。2007年,新加坡华乐团 与新加坡交响乐团, 以及本地其他上百位 演奏家组成的联合大乐团, 共同参与了新 加坡国庆庆典演出, 为国庆典礼增添艺术 色彩。2008年新加坡艺术节,新加坡华乐团 与剧艺工作坊合作, 突破性地让莎士比亚 名著与昆曲经典《牡丹亭》在演出《离梦》 中相会。2009年,新加坡华乐团成为历史 上第一支应邀在爱丁堡艺术节开幕星期演 出的华乐团,也并于2010年参与新加坡艺 术节在法国巴黎的演出。

新加坡华乐团以高演奏水平, 受邀到全球 各地多个重要场合中演出, 包括中国北京、 上海、南宁、苏州、澳门、匈牙利和伦敦。 在2014年, 新加坡华乐团参与上海之春国 Singapore Chinese Orchestra (SCO), inaugurated in 1997, is Singapore's only professional national Chinese orchestra. SCO, made up of more than 80 musicians, occupies the Singapore Conference Hall, which is a national monument. With Prime Minister Lee Hsien Loong as its patron, SCO takes on the twin role of preserving traditional arts and culture and establishing its unique identity through the incorporation of Southeast Asian cultural elements in its music.

SCO has impressed a broadening audience with its blockbuster presentations and is fast establishing itself around the world. In 2002, it staged a symphonic fantasy epic Marco Polo and Princess Blue as part of the opening festival of Esplanade - Theatres on the Bay. The following year, SCO produced a musical and visual conversation with Singapore's most eminent multi-disciplinary artist Tan Swie Hian at the Singapore Arts Festival 2003. SCO celebrated Singapore's 39th National Day in 2004 with a spectacular concert - Our People, Our Music – featuring 2,400 local music enthusiasts at the Singapore Indoor Stadium. In 2005, it produced a mega musical production, Admiral of the Seven Seas, as part of the Singapore Arts Festival 2005. In 2007, SCO was part of the 240-strong combined orchestra that performed at the Singapore National Day Parade. In the Singapore Arts Festival 2008, SCO joined hands with Theatreworks to present the ground-breaking production Awaking, which brought together Kunqu opera music and Elizabethan music. In 2009, SCO made history by becoming the first Chinese orchestra to perform in the opening week of the Edinburgh Festival, and in 2010, performed in Paris as part of the Singapour Festivarts.

Well-known for its high performance standards and versatility, SCO has performed at numerous prestigious events such as the World Economic Forum and International Summit of Arts Council in 2003, and the 2006 International Monetary Fund (IMF) Annual Meeting. SCO has toured various countries and cities including Beijing, Shanghai, Xiamen, Nanning, Suzhou, Macau, Hungary and England. Recently in May 2014, SCO performed at the Shanghai Spring International Music Festival and in Suzhou to celebrate the Singapore-Suzhou Industrial Park's 20th anniversary. In October 2015, SCO

际音乐节以及苏州欢庆新中苏州工业园区 20周年的演出。在2015年,新加坡华乐团 也赴香港荃湾大会堂演奏厅和香港文化中心音乐厅演出两场音乐会。为庆祝新马建 交50周年,新加坡华乐团参与了新加坡文化、社区及青年部于吉隆坡举行的"文化之桥"新加坡文化交流季,在吉隆坡呈献马来西亚首演音乐会《乐飘双峰·荟音乐融》,带领马来西亚的观众踏上新马文化交流的音乐之旅。这些海外音乐会不仅大大提升了新加坡华乐团在国际音乐界的名声,也 奠定了它在华乐界的领导地位。

新加坡华乐团以"人民乐团"为宗旨,通过 社区音乐会、学校艺术教育计划、户外音 乐会等活动来推广华乐, 为使其他种族 的朋友也能欣然地欣赏华乐。新加坡华 乐团也委约作品,于不同音乐会中首演 新作品。新加坡华乐团主办了三届的国际 华乐作曲大赛,分别于2006年,2011年及 2015年。此大赛注入了"南洋"元素,借 此创立本地独有的音乐风格。新加坡华 乐团也于2012年主办了新加坡首次为期 23天的全国华乐马拉松。31支本地华乐 团体在新加坡各地呈献44场演出,吸引 了约两万名观众。2014年6月28日,新加 坡华乐团在国家体育场, 新加坡体育城 缔造了历史性的成就,以4,557名表演者 打破两项健力士世界纪录和三项新加坡 大全记录。新加坡华乐团通过启发、推 动、影响和教育的方式来传达音乐理念, 让优雅华乐举世共赏。



performed two concerts in Hong Kong at the Tsuen Wan Town Hall and Hong Kong Cultural Centre. Commissioned by Ministry of Culture, Community and Youth as part of the Titian Budaya Singapore cultural season in Kuala Lumpur, SCO also held its debut concert in Malaysia at the iconic Petronas Twin Towers. These international platforms provided SCO with the opportunities to showcase its talents and music, propelling it to the forefront of the international music arena.

With its vision to be a world-renowned people's orchestra, SCO widens its outreach by performing regularly at various national parks, communities and schools. SCO also commissions its own compositions and organised the Singapore International Competition for Chinese Orchestral Composition (SICCOC) in 2006, 2011 and 2015 respectively. The competition aims to promote compositions that incorporate music elements from Southeast Asia, also known as "Nanyang music". In 2012, SCO organised Singapore's first 23-day National Chinese Orchestra Marathon, a spectacular feat that drew the participation of 31 local Chinese orchestras which participated with over 44 performances and an audience of 20,000. On 28 June 2014, SCO created history through the second instalment of Our People Our Music by creating two Guinness World Records and three Singapore Book of Records with 4,557 performers at the National Stadium, Singapore Sports Hub. It is with this vision that SCO continues to inspire, influence, educate and communicate through its music.

葉聰 – 音乐总监/指挥 Tsung Yeh – Music Director/Conductor

葉聰于2002年1月应邀出任新加坡华乐团的音乐总监。在他的领导下,新加坡华乐团迅速拓展其演奏曲目。由他策划的大型音乐会包括交响幻想史诗《马可波罗与卜鲁罕公主》、《千年一瞬——与陈瑞献的音乐对话》、《大唐风华》、《雷雨》及《海上第一人——郑和》等。同时,在《离梦》中把汤显祖及莎士比亚名著融为一炉的初步概念也来自他的构思。这些成功的制作不但广受好评,也把华乐艺术推向了更高的层次。葉聰于2013年10月荣获文化界最高荣誉的"新加坡文化奖"。他也现任为新加坡国家青年华乐团顾问。

2007年,葉聰担任新加坡国庆典礼的音乐总监,他为这个举国欢腾的庆典节目作了全新的音乐设计。在国家领袖、27,000名热情观众和上百万名透过现场直播观礼的国人面前,葉聰成功指挥了一个由新加坡华乐团、新加坡交响乐团、马来和印度乐队、南音小组及合唱团所组成的联合乐团。在2004和2014年,葉聰也分别在新加坡室内体育馆和新加坡体育城的国家体育场策划和指挥两场千人大型乐团的音乐会。2014年的4,557演奏家的音乐会破了两项健力士世界记录和三项新加坡记录。

葉聰带领新加坡华乐团走向世界,以他的不断努力和深厚的艺术见解,精心打造出属于乐团自己,融汇中西,富有南洋特色,新加坡华乐团的独特声音。2005年,他带领乐团远赴伦敦、盖茨黑德,以及布达佩斯春季艺术节,成功指挥了一系列的欧洲巡演。2007年10月,乐团在他的领导下,展开了中国巡演之旅,先后在北京国际音乐节、上海国际艺术节、澳门国际音乐节、广州星海音乐厅、中山市文化艺术中心和深圳音乐厅中成功演出。2009年8月,乐团成为历史上第一支应邀在爱丁堡艺术节开幕周演出的华乐团。

葉聰自1988年至2016年担任美国南湾 交响乐团音乐总监。1995年,他与南湾 交响乐团更获颁美国作曲家、作家及出 版商协会大奖荣衔。在2016年5月7日, 南弯市市长Pete Buttigieg宣布那天为 Tsung Yeh joined the Singapore Chinese Orchestra (SCO) as Music Director in January 2002. Under his direction, SCO expanded its repertoire with innovative works such as Marco Polo and Princess Blue — A Symphonic Epic, Instant is a Millennium – A Musical Conversation with Tan Swie Hian, The Grandeur of Tang, Thunderstorm, Admiral of the Seven Seas

and Awaking. In Awaking, he melded Shakespeare and Tang Xianzu's plays into one, elevating Chinese orchestral music to a higher level. In 2013, Tsung Yeh was awarded the Cultural Medallion, the highest accolade in the arts. He is also the advisor to the Singapore National Youth Chinese Orchestra.

As Music Director of Singapore's National Day Parade 2007, Tsung Yeh conceptualised a symphonic music structure with supreme, textured virtuosity that incensed the national pride in the air. 240 musicians from the SCO, Singapore Symphony Orchestra, Singapore Armed Forces Central Band, Malay and Indian ensemble, Nanyin ensemble and a chorus performed under his baton before an audience of 27,000 and millions of television viewers. In 2004 and 2014, Tsung Yeh directed two mega orchestra concerts at the Singapore Indoor Stadium and National Stadium, Singapore Sports Hub respectively, of which, 2014's concert of 4,557 musicians broke 2 Guinness World Records and 3 Singapore Book of Records.

Tsung Yeh has brought SCO internationally and developed the special artistic identity of SCO through the orchestra's sound and texture, comprising of East and West and Nanyang heritage, which is unique to SCO. In March and April 2005, he led the orchestra on a tour to Europe at Barbican Centre in London, The Sage Gateshead and the Budapest Spring Festival. In October 2007, SCO performed at the Beijing Music Festival, China Shanghai International Arts Festival, Macau International Music Festival, as well as at major concert halls in Guangzhou, Zhongshan and Shenzhen. In August 2009, SCO made history by becoming the first Chinese orchestra to perform in the opening week of the Edinburgh Festival.

Tsung Yeh was the Music Director of the South Bend Symphony Orchestra (SBSO) in the United States from 1988 to 2016. In 1995, he was honoured with the ASCAP Award with the South Bend Symphony Orchestra. Upon his retirement from SBSO, Tsung Yeh was presented the "Sagamore of the Wabash Award" from the Indiana State – the highest honour given by the Indiana Governor, Mike Pence. 7 May 2016 was proclaimed "Tsung Yeh Day" by the Mayor of the South Bend City, Pete

"Tsung Yeh Day" (葉聰日)。葉聰也荣获印第安纳州州长Mike Pence颁发的印地安纳州最高平民奖 "Sagamore of the Wabash Award"。葉聰现被定为南湾交响乐团协会桂冠指挥。他曾被挑选参加由芝加哥交响乐团主办的"指挥家深造计划",并接受其音乐总监巴伦邦及首席客座指挥布莱兹的指导。他也曾任西北印第安那州交响乐团音乐总监、香港小交响乐团的音乐总监、圣路易交响乐团助理指挥、佛罗里达州管弦乐团驻团指挥、纽约奥尔班尼交响乐团的首席客座指挥。

葉聰曾与北美多个乐团合作, 计有三藩市、塔克逊、纽黑文交响乐、卡尔加明特管弦乐团等。1991年4月, 他临时代替抱恙的巴伦邦登上指挥台, 成功领导芝加哥交响乐团的3场演出。他也经常应邀担任亚洲多个乐团的活演出。他指挥, 包括北京、上海、广州、深圳, 海、台北、东京和横滨的乐团。欧洲州国、他指挥过巴黎 2e2m合奏团、流明、他指挥过巴黎 2e2m合奏团、法师乐团和波兰、俄罗斯及捷克的乐团等。他曾同雨果、Delos与 Naxos等公司合作录制了多张音乐光碟专辑。

葉聰在指挥教育界亦极富盛誉。他曾是捷克交响乐指挥工作坊的艺术总监,并曾在美国"指挥家联盟"与北美交响乐团联合会举办的工作坊担任讲师。他也曾到北京、上海、香港、台湾和新加坡多次举办指挥大师班。他近年来的新任命,包括中央民族乐团首席客座指挥、江苏大剧院艺术委员和上海音乐学院何禄汀中国音乐高等研究院学术委员。

Buttigieg. Tsung Yeh is presently designated as the Conductor Laureate by the South Bend Symphony Orchestra Association.

As part of the Conductors' Mentor Programme sponsored by the Chicago Symphony Orchestra, he worked with Music Director Daniel Barenboim and Principal Guest Conductor Pierre Boulez. Tsung Yeh was formerly the Music Director of the Northwest Indiana Symphony Orchestra and Hong Kong Sinfonietta, and the Exxon/Arts Endowment Conductor of the Saint Louis Symphony Orchestra. He served as Resident Conductor of Florida Orchestra and was the Principal Guest Conductor of Albany Symphony Orchestra of New York.

Tsung Yeh has collaborated with reputable international orchestras including San Francisco, Tucson and New Haven Symphonies, Calgary and Rochester Philharmonic, and orchestras from Beijing, Shanghai, Guangzhou, Shenzhen, Hong Kong, Taipei, Tokyo, Yokohama, France, the Royal Scottish National Orchestra, Poland, Russia and Czech Republic. In April 1991, he replaced the indisposed Barenboim at short notice and conducted 3 successful concerts. As a recording artist, Tsung Yeh has made various recordings under the HUGO, Delos and Naxos labels.

Tsung Yeh is a distinguished professor at the China Conservatory of Music and guest professor at the Shanghai Conservatory of Music. He has taught conducting workshops hosted by the Conductors Guild, The League of American Orchestras and the Musik Hochschule of Zurich and is also active in conducting masterclasses in Beijing, Shanghai, Hong Kong, Taiwan and Singapore. His new appointment in recent years include the Principal Guest Conductor of the China National Traditional Orchestra, Artistic Committee Member of the Jiangsu Centre for the Performing Arts and Senior Researcher of the He Luting Chinese Music Research Institute of Shanghai Conservatory of Music.

吕思清 – 小提琴 Lu Si Qing – Violin



作为当今乐坛最知名的杰出中国小提琴家,吕思清经常受邀与 国内外著名乐团合作演出及举办独奏音乐会,并每年定期带领 他于2011年创办的"美杰中国三重奏"举行室内乐音乐会。他 那美妙动听、激动人心的琴声早已遍布世界四十多个国家和地 区的著名演出场所,如维也纳金色大厅、美国纽约林肯艺术中 心、洛杉矶好来坞碗型剧场、渥太华国家艺术中心、蒙特利尔 艺术广场、英国巴比肯中心、伦敦皇家歌剧院、威格莫尔音乐 厅、法国巴黎香榭丽舍大剧院、凡尔赛宫路易十四歌剧院、俄 罗斯莫斯科音乐大会堂、日本东京三得利音乐厅、澳大利亚墨 尔本艺术中心、悉尼歌剧院、新加坡滨海艺术中心、阿布扎比 酋长皇宫礼堂、中国国家大剧院等。

吕思清与国内外顶尖指挥家和音乐家保持着密切的合作,其中包括 洛林•马泽尔、瓦列里•捷吉耶夫、莱昂纳德·斯拉特金、艾度•迪华特、弗拉基米尔•阿什肯纳齐、劳伦斯•福斯特、梵志登、奥斯莫•万斯卡、米歇尔·普拉松、波切利,余隆、郎朗、吕嘉、汤沐海、谭利华,吕绍嘉、简文彬、林昭亮、王羽佳、王健、张弦、张艺、李心草、杨洋、上海弦乐四重奏以及奥斯卡获奖者、作曲家/指挥家

谭盾等。吕思清并于2011年与谭盾在波兰为他的小提琴协奏曲《英雄》做了世界首演。

诸多当今知名的乐团也与吕思清多次合作,其中包括英国皇家爱乐乐团、英国爱乐乐团、伦敦交响乐团、德国莱 茵国家交响乐团、哈雷管弦乐团、西班牙毕尔巴鄂交响乐团、瑞士伯尔尼交响乐团、萨尔茨堡室内乐团、纽伦堡 交响乐团、阿斯彭节日乐团、好来坞碗型剧场乐团、华盛顿交响乐团、新泽西交响乐团、温哥华交响乐团、马林 斯基剧院交响乐团、俄罗斯国家交响乐团、悉尼交响乐团、墨尔本交响乐团、日本读卖新闻交响乐团、香港管弦 乐团、国家大剧院管弦乐团、中国爱乐乐团、中国国家交响乐团、国立台湾交响乐团等。

过去一年中吕思清奉上了多场精彩绝伦的演出,其中包括在40余个城市举办的"魔弓传奇"吕思清独奏音乐会中国巡演、与国家大剧院交响乐团亮相阿联酋阿布扎比音乐节、与上海爱乐乐团参加泰国曼谷国际舞蹈音乐节、与张弦执棒的新泽西交响乐团在林肯艺术中心举行音乐会、与中国交响乐团合作在悉尼歌剧院演出、与谭盾及伦敦交响乐团于英国巴比肯中心举行音乐会、受邀作为独奏家与青岛交响乐团赴南美洲展开其乐团历史上首次的拉美巡演。

吕思清目前还担任北京国家大剧院"五月音乐节"的艺术总监及他于2016年创办的"吕思清·深圳福田国际弦乐艺术节"艺术总监。吕思清与飞利浦Philips、拿索斯Naxos、马可波罗Marco Paolo、以及其他知名唱片公司合作出版了多张专辑,其中与西班牙尔巴鄂交响乐团合作的。《萨拉萨蒂小提琴作品名演》大获成功。此外,他使用六把斯特拉迪瓦里、瓜奈里、阿玛蒂意大利名琴演奏并于多伦多室内乐团合作录制的"维瓦尔第《四季》名琴版",则被权威乐评家称为"演绎与录音均属A+天碟级,是可遇不可求的无敌制作"。他还曾录制过四版《梁祝》小提琴协奏曲,其发行量数以百万,并被喻为当今最佳版本。吕思清的专辑《梦幻曲-吕思清浪漫小提琴曲集》1997年在香港发行后,即被台湾《音乐时代》、《中国时报》评为每月最佳唱片、《音响论坛》年度最佳100张唱片。吕思清的演奏经常在包括美国《纽约时报》WQXR音乐台、芝加哥WFMT音乐厅、波士顿WBGH电台、加拿大CBC电台、德国WDR音乐台、瑞士伯尔尼电台、香港凤凰卫视、亚洲电视、第四电台等全球上百个电视台和电台中播出。

吕思清1969年生于中国山东青岛市。他四岁开始学习小提琴,八岁被中央音乐学院附小破格录取,师从王振山教授,成为这所著名学府有史以来最为年轻的学生,11岁被世界著名小提琴家耶胡迪·梅纽因选到英国他创办的天才音乐学校学习。1984年回国继续深造,师从世界著名小提琴教育家德罗希·迪蕾女士及姜康先生。此外,吕思清除获得帕格尼尼金奖外,还赢得过北京、英国及美国等多个重要国际比赛大奖。

吕思清经常使用意大利制琴大师亚历山德罗·加利亚诺1709年制作的以及耶稣·瓜奈利1734年制作的名为"里奇"的小提琴(ex-Ricci Guarneri del Gesu violin),这把瓜奈利名琴是由吕思清的好友,音乐爱好者/艺术收藏家/企业家Z先生慷慨提供的。

Well recognized as one of the most outstanding Chinese violinists today, Siqing Lu (pronounced See-Ching Lyu) performs regularly with major international and Chinese orchestras, in recitals and with the China Trio which he founded in 2011. He has performed to acclaim in some of the world's most prestigious concert halls in more than forty countries and territories worldwide, including the Musikverein in Vienna, Avery Fisher Hall and Alice Tully Hall in New York City, Hollywood Bowl in Los Angeles, Southam Hall at National Arts Centre in Ottawa, Maison Symphonique and Place des Arts in Montreal, Barbican Centre, Royal Opera House and Wigmore Hall in London, Theatre Des Champs Elysees and Louis XIV Opera House at Palace of Versailles in Paris, the Great Hall in Moscow, Suntory Hall in Tokyo, Hamer Hall at the Arts Centre in Melbourne, Sydney Opera House, the Esplanade in Singapore, Emirates Palace in Abu Dhabi and the National Centre for the Performing Arts in Beijing.

Siqing Lu has collaborated with many of the world's esteemed conductors and musicians, including Lorin Maazel, Valery Gergiev, Leonard Slatkin, Edo de Waart, Vladimir Ashkenazy, Lawrence Foster, Jaap van Zweden, Osmo Vänskä, Michel Plasson, Bocelli, as well as leading Chinese musicians such as Long Yu, Lang Lang, Jia Lu, Muhai Tang, Shao-Jia Lu, Wen-Bin Jian, Cho-Liang Lin, Yujia Wang, Jian Wang, Xian Zhang, Yi Zhang, Xincao Li, Yang Yang, the Shanghai Quartet and Oscar award winner composer/conductor Tan Dun, with whom Siqing gave the world premiere of his violin concerto "Hero" in Poland in 2011.

Siqing Lu has performed with some of today's leading orchestras such as the Philharmonia Orchestra, Royal Philharmonic Orchestra, London Symphony Orchestra, Deutsche Staatsphilharmonie Rheinland-Pfalz, Halle Orchestra, Bilbao Symphony, Berne Symphony Orchestra, Salzburg Chamber Orchestra, Nuremberg Symphony Orchestra, Aspen Festival Orchestra, Hollywood Bowl Orchestra, Washington Symphony Orchestra, New Jersey Symphony Orchestra, Vancouver Symphony Orchestra, Symphony Orchestra of the Mariinsky Theatre, Russia National Orchestra, Sydney Symphony Orchestra, Melbourne Symphony Orchestra, Yomiuri Nippon Symphony, Hong Kong Philharmonic, Symphony Orchestra of the NCPA, China Philharmonic Orchestra, China National Symphony Orchestra, and the National Symphony Orchestra of Taiwan, among others.

Highlights of the past year includes a forty-city recital tour in China, concerts with the NCPA Orchestra at the Abu Dhabi Music Festival, with the Shanghai Philharmonic Orchestra at the Bangkok International Dance and Music Festival, with the New Jersey Symphony Orchestra conducted by Xian Zhang at Lincoln Centre, with the China National Symphony Orchestra at the Sydney Opera House, with Tan Dun and the London Symphony Orchestra at the Barbican Centre, as well as guest soloist with the Qingdao Symphony Orchestra on their historic first ever South America tour

Siqing Lu is currently the Artistic Director of the China National Center for the Performing Arts (NCPA) May Music Festival and the Siqing Lu Shenzhen Futian International String Festival which he founded in 2016.

Siqing Lu plays regularly on a 1709 Alessandra Gagliano and a 1734 ex-Ricci Guarneri del Gesu violin, which is graciously loaned to him by his close friend Mr. J Zhou, a passionate music lover, collector and successful entrepreneur.

李国煌 – 司仪/旁述/演唱 Mark Lee – Host/Narrator/Vocal



李国煌在新加坡可谓家喻户晓。这位精力过剩的喜剧演员兼主持人,已在本地演艺圈驰骋20余年。

随着电视制作的成功,他也踏入了电影行业。从他在第一部喜剧电影《钱不够用》饰演承包商阿华至今,他已参与超过20部本地和区域电影的制作。

他的专业态度和精湛演技,让他四度 获颁"最佳喜剧演员奖"与多次入选 为"十大最受欢迎男艺人"之一。

虽然他以扮演喜剧角色为主,他也是位深受欢迎的电视主持人,曾主持甚多得到高度评价的综艺节目,例如:《有话好好说》、《摆家乐》、《国际交易所》和《美差事。苦差事》。他幽默的主持风格让他荣获多个"最佳综艺主持人"奖项。

2009年,他除了在新加坡电影节获颁"最佳男主角奖",也演出首个单人脱口秀。一年后,他的事业再攀高峰,于红星大奖2010荣获"超级红星奖",也拍了首部电影《鬼也笑》。

Comedian-cum-host, Mark Lee is a well-known Singaporean actor-host, who has been in the local entertainment scene for over two decades.

Following his success in television productions, Mark ventured into the film industry. Since his first major feature-film as a contractor in the 1998 box-office hit "Money No Enough", Mark has appeared in more than 30 local and regional movies.

His professionalism and excellent performing skills have earned him the Best Comedy Performer award for 4 years and consistently voted as one of the Top 10 Most Popular Male Artistes at the annual Star Awards.

Although known mostly for playing comedic roles, he is also a sought-after TV host having anchored many highly-rated variety shows such as "Say It If You Dare", "Home Décor Survivor", "Please Be My Guest", "It's A Small World" and "Behind Every Job". His entertaining hosting styles have won him multiple awards for Best Variety Show Host.

In 2009, Mark not only won Best Actor at Singapore Film Fest but he also staged his first solo talk show. His career soared to greater heights a year later when he received the coveted All-Time Favourite Artiste award at Star Awards 2010 and made his movie directorship debut with "The Ghost Must Be Crazy".

陈碧玉 – 司仪/演唱 Chen Biyu – Host/Vocal



嘹亮及甜美的嗓音让碧玉赢得很多的忠实听众。对工作充满热忱的她,确保自己每一天给听众不同的惊喜。和蔼可亲,风趣幽默的碧玉能够在不同的场合吸引大家的瞩目。她的好歌喉常常能在广播节目中听到,是听众们有目共睹的。碧玉也在每个周末主持"走过岁月的歌",让听众们回味70-80年代令人难忘的经典歌曲。

身为97.2电台DJ, 碧玉主持过许多节目。近日的节目就包括了与李国煌、周重庆及陈建彬搭档主持早晨时段的《早安! 玉建煌崇》。这个节目深受听众喜爱, 也让碧玉在2016年广播80金麦奖, 获颁最喜爱组合奖。 主持功利一流的碧玉也在2004年荣获《金麦奖 2004最佳节目主持人》及荣获《金麦奖2013飞跃突破奖》。

除了电台的幕后工作, 碧玉也担任目前的主持人, 主持各种97.2或电台相关的户外活动。此外碧玉也是2013年曾兄弟旅游展销会的主持人。

Dubbed "the host with the nightingale vocals", Biyu's crystal-clear voice has gained her a following of loyal listeners. This dedicated DJ creates unique content daily to entertain her listeners. Biyu's humorous side enables her to engage a crowd in different situations. Her vocals can also often be heard on radio which never fails to lighten up listeners' heart. On top of this, Biyu also hosts "Never Say Goodbye" -- a benchmark programme of 97.2FM which plays the unforgettable and classic songs of 70-80's evergreen singers.

A long time serving radio DJ at 97.2FM, Biyu has hosted many programmes and is currently hosting a popular morning belt radio programme with Mark Lee, Dennis Chew and Marcus Chin titled "Good Morning! Yu Jian Huang Chong", where she won the Golden Mic Awards 2016 and the Most Popular Group Award. Her amazing deejay skills have also earned her awards such as the 2004 Golden Mike Awards – Best Programme Host for Love Chinese Oldies, MediaCorp Radio Award – Breakthrough Personality of the Year.

Besides being behind the scenes, Biyu also took her skills on stage where she hosted various LOVE 972 events and station parties as well as the Chan Brothers Summit Travel Fair in 2013.

曲目介绍 Programme Notes

春节序曲 Spring Festival Overture

李焕之作曲、沈文友移植 Composed by Li Huan Zhi, adapted by Sim Boon Yew

音乐的背景取自中国的一个农村,四处都是庆祝春节的欢乐场面。气氛热闹欢愉,响着民间秧歌舞的音调和节奏。接着是抒情而优美的乐段,极富田园风味。末段是全曲最热闹的部分,其展现一波又一波的欢腾场面,并在原有曲调上加以扩展。原为著名中国作曲家李焕之在1949年为西洋管弦乐而作,此版本是沈文友为《春花齐放2009》音乐会委约而移植。

The background of this piece is based on a rural village in China, featuring scenes of festive celebrations for the New Year. With the music and rhythms of the yangko dance, it is followed by a lyrical and melodious section that presents a picturesque flavour. The final section, which develops from the original melody, is the liveliest, as it showcases jubilation scenes in succession. Originally composed by well-known Chinese composer Li Huan Zhi in 1949 for symphony orchestra, this version was re-arranged by Sim Boon Yew for Rhapsodies of Spring 2009 concert.

李焕之 (1919-2000年) 原名李昭彩,又名李钟焕,是著名作曲家、指挥家、音乐理论家。1938年在鲁迅艺术书学院师从洗海星学习作指挥。为历任中央音乐学院音乐团团长、中央歌舞团艺术指中央民族乐团团长。代表作品有《春节序曲》、《春节区组曲》、《泊罗江幻想曲》(等协奏曲)及《秦王破阵月》等。

Li Huan Zhi (b.1919-2000) formerly known as Li Zhao Cai, and also known as Li Zhong Huan, was a famous composer, conductor and music theorist. In 1938, he studied composition and conducting at the Lu Xun Academy of the Arts under the tutelage of Xian Xing Hai. He was the head of orchestra at the Central Conservatory of Music, artistic director of the Central Song and Dance Ensemble, and the head of the Chinese National Orchestra. His representative works include Spring Festival Overture, Spring Festival Suite and Reminiscenes of the Hometown, Miluo River Fantasia (a concerto for zheng) and The King of Qin in Battle.

沈文友(生于1954年)是新加坡知名华乐工作者和编曲者,前任新加坡华乐团中胡演奏家,兼任驻团编曲。沈文友编写的各类型华乐作品已超过150首,其中有不少深具有本土特色。荣膺2001年新加坡共和国总统颂赐公共服务奖章。

Sim Boon Yew (b.1954) is a well-known Chinese orchestral music practitioner and arranger, former SCO'S zhonghu musician. Till date, Sim Boon Yew has arranged more than 150 compositions, with many of them rich in our unique local flavour. In 2001, he was conferred the Public Service Award by His Excellency, the President of Singapore.

《四季》小提琴协奏曲 之《春》

La Primavera from Le Quattro Stagioni The Four Seasons Violin Concerto No. 1 in E Major, Op. 8, RV 269, "Spring" 安东尼奥・维瓦尔第作曲、 埃里克・沃森移植 Composed by Antonio Vivaldi, adapted by Eric Watson

《四季》之《春》第一小提琴协奏曲,作品8,RV 269是一组由意大利作曲家安东尼奥•维瓦尔第创作,以音乐描述一年四季的小提琴协奏曲。《四季》是维瓦尔弟最广为人知的作品之一,创作于1723年,并于1725年出版。

《四季》中的每一首协奏曲皆用音乐展示出各季节的画面,以三个乐句或意念反映在三个乐章(快一慢一快)中。在这首《春》里,我们可聆听鸟儿的歌声和颤声。乐谱上附有相信是维瓦尔弟的创作,是一首与春天有关的诗歌。这部作品展现了最初期、最详细,以及极具叙事元素的标题音乐。

第一乐章: 春天迎我们而来

鸟儿以节日的歌曲欢庆她的归来,而淙淙的流水被轻轻的微风轻抚着。雷暴,那春天的使者怒吼,把黑色斗篷掷到天堂去,以致他们消失在沉默。这时,鸟儿再一次唱起迷人的歌曲。

第二乐章: 广板

在鲜花开遍的花丛, 树枝在上面沙沙作响。当山羊群在睡觉时, 他忠实的狗就在身旁。

第三乐章: 快板

在乡村风笛喜庆乐声之带领下, 若虫和牧羊人在春天灿烂的天篷下翩翩起舞。

原谱是给弦乐和大提琴通奏低音(通奏低音是一条附有和弦音程数字的低音线,需要由演奏者即兴发挥或填满。这可以由多种乐器演奏,例如键盘和管风琴)。埃里克•沃森从原谱进行移植,以笙和弹拨乐分别演绎原来管风琴与古键琴的声部。

The Four Seasons is a group of four violin concerti by Antonio Vivaldi, which offers a musical expression for the four seasons. The Four Seasons, one of the best known of Vivaldi's works, was written in 1723 and published in 1725.

Each concerto uses music to illustrate differing aspects of each season, which is divided into three phrases or ideas reflected in the three movements (fast-slow-fast) of each concerto. In this concerto, Spring, you can look forward to hearing the sound of birds singing and trilling. The score is accompanied by a poem about spring, which is supposedly written by Vivaldi himself. This provides one of the earliest and most detailed examples of what is later known program music—music with a narrative element.

First movement: Giunt' è la Primavera e festosetti (Springtime is upon us)

The birds celebrate her return with a festive song, alongside murmuring streams softly caressed by the breezes. Thunderstorms, the heralds of Spring, begin their roar and cast their dark mantle over heaven. Then, silence returns, and the birds begin performing their charming songs once again.

Second movement: Largo

There is a flower-filled meadow, with leafy branches rustling overhead. The faithful dog lies beside the shepherd while the sheep are fast asleep.

Third movement: Allegro

Led by the festive sound of rustic bagpipes, nymphs and shepherds dance lightly beneath the brilliant canopy of spring.

The original score was for strings with cello continuo (a continuo is a bass line with chord interval numbers above it that has to be improvised or filled in by the player, it can be for several instruments and usually includes a keyboard and organ). Eric Watson adapted it from the original score by reproducing the sound of the organ on the sheng and the harpsichord on the plucked strings.

埃里克·沃森(生于1946年)于英国出生,受训于伦敦圣三一音乐学院。埃里克·沃森居住新加坡,是本地活跃 的作曲家、指挥家、音乐技师和教育家。他的创作跨越不同的音乐流派,包括电声音乐、甘美兰和华乐团。2001 年,他担任新加坡国庆庆典音乐创作和音乐总监,与新加坡交响乐团录制了一首管弦乐曲。2007年,他再次为 国庆庆典作曲和改编,与四组不同的乐团合作一新加坡交响乐、新加坡华乐团、一印度组合和一马来组合。埃 里克·沃森的创作《挂毯: 时光飞舞》赢得了2006新加坡国际华乐作曲比赛首奖。埃里克·沃森在教职工作中, 对古典和现代音乐进行创作与编排,对爵士和即兴技巧具有这特殊兴趣。埃里克·沃森是现任的新加坡华乐团 驻团作曲家。

Eric Watson (b.1946) was born in the UK and received tertiary musical training at the London Trinity College of Music. Eric Watson has lived in Singapore as a composer, conductor, music technologist and pedagogue. He has written many scores in many diverse and different genres including electroacoustic music, gamelan and Chinese orchestra. Eric Watson was the composer and music director for the Singapore National Day Parade 2001, for which he recorded an orchestral score with the Singapore Symphony Orchestra (SSO). In 2007, he wrote and arranged orchestral music for the National Day Parade, collaborating with four different orchestras - SSO, SCO and Indian ensemble and a Malay ensemble. In 2006, Eric Watson's work Tapestries-Time Dances was awarded first prize at the Singapore Chinese International Competition for Chinese Orchestral Composition. Eric Watson takes a special interest in teaching both classical and contemporary orchestration, composition, jazz and improvisational techniques. He is currently the composer-in-residence of SCO.

旁述与乐队:管弦丝竹知多少 Narration and Orchestra:

关迺忠作曲 Composed by Kuan Nai-chung

Instrumental Guide to the Chinese Orchestra

本曲是一首介绍华乐乐器的作品,以江苏民歌《茉莉花》为主题,创作成一首乐队变奏曲。乐曲分成五个段落。前四 个段落分别介绍了吹管乐器、弹拨乐器、打击乐器与拉弦乐器。在最后的段落,作曲家把之前所介绍过的所有乐器 放在乐团的合奏中, 让它们依次再现, 也让观众进一步了解各种乐器在乐团里的重要性和功能。

This composition is based on the Jiangsu folk song, Jasmine Flower, and is a set of variations for the orchestra. It serves as a novice guide to traditional Chinese orchestral instruments. This piece consists of five sections, with the first four introducing the wind, plucked-string, percussion and bowed-string instruments. The final section recalls all the instruments introduced previously in the orchestral performance so that the audience will have a better understanding of their individual functionality and importance.

关迺忠(生于1939年)曾担任中国东方歌舞团指挥及驻团作曲及、中国艺术团驻团作曲家、香港中乐团音乐总 高雄市国乐团驻团指挥、中国音乐学院特聘教授和华夏民族乐团桂冠指挥。主要作品《拉萨行》、《丰年祭》, 《云南风情》和《台湾风情》。

Kuan Nai-chung (b.1939) was formerly the Conductor and Composer-in-Residence of the China Oriental Song and Dance Troupe. He was also the Composer-in-Residence of the China Arts Troupe Music Director of the Hong Kong Chinese Orchestra and the Conductor-in-Residence of Kaohsiung City Chinese Orchestra, Distinguished Professor of the China Conservatory of Music and the Conductor Laureate of the Huaxia Traditional Music Orchestra. His major compositions include A Trip to Lhasa, Harvest Festival, Charms of Yunnan and Scenic Taiwan.

电影与乐队:回家过年 Movie and Orchestra: The Reunion Dinner

陈哲艺导演、罗伟伦作曲 Directed by Anthony Chen, Composed by Law Wai Lun

《回家过年》以除夕夜为背景, 讲述的是一户新加坡华人家庭四十年来随着时代的成长与改变。故事始于1970年, 从 10岁小学生阿文的视角出发,描述他与理发师父亲阿德之间的感情。电影呈现一幅温馨的新加坡家庭图景,细腻捕 捉了父与子之间既别扭又含蓄的爱。 这部作品于2011年由《春到河畔》委约并由新加坡华乐团同年世界首演。

With Chinese New Year Eve as a backdrop, *The Reunion Dinner* tells the story of how a Singaporean Chinese family has lived over a period of 40 years. Told through the eyes of 10 year old schoolboy, Boon, from 1970 onwards, it traces the relationship between him and his barber father, Teck. The film is a moving portrait of family life in Singapore, capturing the often awkward, subdued and unspoken love between a father and his son. This work was commissioned by River Hongbao in 2011 for the Singapore Chinese Orchestra and was world premiered in 2011.

陳哲艺 (生于1984年) 是新加坡电影导演和编剧。他的首部长片《爸妈不在家》,获得2013年第66屆坎城影展 金摄影机奖、第50屆金马奖最佳新导演奖,最佳原著剧本奖和最佳剧情片奖。《爸妈不在家》在东西方影壇皆 备受瞩目, 並获得多个影展及电影奖项肯定, 陈哲艺亦成为2013年度最炙手可熱的电影人, 更位列好莱坞顶级 杂志《VARIETY》所推选的"年度全球最值得关注的10位导演"。

Anthony Chen (b.1984) is a Singaporean film director and producer. He started pursuing film at the young age of 17 and collectively his short films have screened and awarded at numerous prestigious film festivals including Cannes, Berlin, Rotterdam, Busan, London, Sao Paulo, Stockholm, Sydney, Montreal, Melbourne, Chicago and Hawaii. In 2013, his debut feature film, ILO ILO (2013), won the prestigious Camera d'Or at the 2013 Cannes Film Festival. He also won the 50th Golden Horse Award for Best Film, Best New Director and Best Screenplay. ILO ILO became the most successful arthouse film in the history of Singapore cinema both commercially and critically, winning over 40 awards and achieving box office success in various territories.

罗伟伦(生于1944年)于1967年毕业于北京中央音乐学院作曲系,曾担任北京中央新闻纪录电影制片厂的专职 作曲及香港演艺学院讲师。1995年移居新加坡,并创作了多个大型作品如《天网》、国庆2007的大型音乐会,华 艺节的《陈洁仪—我的音乐之旅》2011和《神女》默片音乐会2014等。他的作品《海上第一人 — 郑和》在2006 年新加坡国际作曲大赛中获荣誉奖。2007年、《彩云追月》荣获香港作曲家与作词家协会颁发金帆奖。罗伟伦 也曾担任新加坡华乐团驻团作曲家及经常担任音乐比评委。他在2017年获颁文化奖。

Law Wai Lun (b. 1944) graduated from the Central Conservatory of Music in 1967 and became a fulltime composer at the Central Newsreel and Documentary Film Studio in Beijing, and was later appointed a lecturer at the Hong Kong Academy for Performing Arts. He migrated to Singapore in 1905 and continues to compose several major works such as The Celestial Web, music for the 2007 national day dance musical, Kit Chan - My Musical Journey and The Goddess - A Silent Film Concert at Huayi Festivals 2011 and 2014. His work, Admiral of the Seven Seas, received the honorary award at the Singapore International Competition for Chinese Orchestral Composition 2006, and Beautiful Clouds Chasing the Moon also awarded the Golden Sail Award by the Composers and Authors Society of Hong Kong in 2007. He was SCO's composer-in-residence from 2012 to 2014 and often appointed as judge for various music competitions. He was awarded the Singapore Cultural Medallion award in 2017.

小提琴与乐队:金色的炉台 Violin and Orchestra: The Golden Platform of the Steel-smelting Furnace 陈钢作曲、潘耀田改编 Composed by Chen Gang, re-arranged by Phoon Yew Tien

这原是一首表现钢炼工人的歌曲,作曲家陈钢于上世纪七十年代改编成了小提琴独奏曲。乐曲除了形象化地体现其时代精神风貌,也充分发挥小提琴在激越以及抒情方面的巨大表现潜力。如今它改为大乐团协奏,更能把乐曲的张力和幅度提升到另一个层次和高度。

This work was originally a song written to depict the steelmaker. Composer Chen Gang arranged it into a violin solo piece in the 1970s. Besides embodying the spirit of the era, it gives a full play to the vigor and lyrical features of the violin. Today, this concerto will be accompanied by a large orchestra, creating greater musical tension and excitement.

陈钢 (生于1935年) 是中国当代著名的作曲家。早年,他师从于父亲陈歌辛和匈牙利钢琴家瓦拉学习作曲和钢琴。1955年考入上海音乐学院后,他又师从于丁善德和苏联音乐专家阿尔扎马诺夫学期作曲与理论。求学期间与何占豪合作制小提琴协奏曲《梁祝》蜚声中外乐坛。这首流传最广的中国交响乐作品曾先后荣获五次金唱片与白金唱片奖。陈钢现为上海音乐学院作曲系教授。他曾出访美国、加拿大、法国、新加坡、香港、日本、台湾等并载入"世界名人录"、"世界音乐名人录"等十八项世界名人录,并获"国际文化荣誉证书"

Chen Gang (b.1935) is a well-known Chinese composer. He studied under the tutelage of his father Chen Ge Xin and Hungarian Roma pianist Walla, taking lessons in composition and the piano. In 1955, he entered the Shanghai Conservatory of Music, where he studied with composer He Zhan Hao to compose the legendary violin concerto *Butterfly Lovers* during his school days. The work remains one of the most widely circulated orchestral works around the world and has won five gold records and platinum awards. Chen Gang is currently a professor off Composition Department at the Shanghai Conservatory of Music. He has toured the United Stated, Canada, France, Singapore, Hong Kong, Japan , Taiwan, and is included on "Who's Who in the World", as well as 'Who's Who of Music Around the World:, and won the "International Cultural Honor".

潘耀田(生于1952年)是新加坡华著名作曲家。于1996, 1997, 2001, 2004 和 2009年, 受到新加坡词曲版权协会颁发之奖项与认可。1996年也荣获国家艺术理事会颁发新加坡文化界最高荣誉之一的国家文化奖。创作之余,潘耀田于1998年至2008年, 担任新加坡国家艺术理事会艺术顾问。2000年, 委托为新加坡国歌重新编曲。2003年更亦为新加坡交响乐团驻团作曲家。

Phoon Yew Tien (b. 1952) is a renowned composer in Singapore. He received awards from COMPASS in 1996, 1997, 2001, 2004 and 2009 for his contributions to the music industry. He was also awarded the Cultural Medallion in 1996 by the National Arts Council, which is the highest award given in the field of the arts in Singapore. Phoon Yew Tien has served as an arts advisor to the National Arts Council from 1998 to 2008, where he was appointed to rearrange the Singapore national anthem in 2000. In 2003, he was appointed as Singapore Symphony Orchestra's composer-in-residence.

小提琴与乐队:打虎上山 Violin and Orchestra: Taking the Tiger Mountain by Strategy 陈钢、谭抒真、张振山改编自 现代京剧《智取威虎山》、潘耀田改编 Re-arranged from the modern opera Hunting Tiger up the Mountain by Chen Gang, Tan Shu Zhen, Zhang Zhen Shan, re-arranged by Phoon Yew Tien

这乐曲又名《迎来春色换人间》,是七十年代晚期根据京剧《智取威虎山》中《打虎上山》的音乐改编而成。乐曲吸收了京剧中"紧拉慢唱"的表现手法,小提琴先是模仿京胡的"紧拉",快弓演奏出火热的旋律,好比那东北山林剿匪的火热年代;接着又是宛如人声的慢弓,抒发出主人公杨子荣的豪情,然后是交替的演绎,把京剧的韵味表现得淋漓尽致。

Also known as *Spring Bringing Us a New World*, this piece was an adaptation of the act "Hunting Tiger Up the Mountain" in the late 70s' Peking opera "Taking Tiger Mountain by Strategy". Incorporating the use of the "jin la man chang" (slow singing with fast accompaniment) technique commonly seen in Peking operas, the violin mimics the jinghu and delivers a passionate tune with a fast bow to bring out the heated years of campaign to suppress bandits in Northeast China, followed by a slow bow that resembles human speaking and displays the ambitiousness of the protagonist Yang Zi Rong. The piece then uses both bowing techniques to vividly bring out the charm of Peking operas.
