Our \$96 million redevelopment works, which included demolishing six buildings and renovating four others, took more than two years to complete. The redeveloped KWSH has a new 12-storey building with more than 600 beds, a senior care centre, a traditional Chinese medicine centre and a heritage gallery.

We moved into the new nursing home in September 2017 and residents now enjoy features such as the terrace garden and various thematic day spaces. The new wards are also bigger and better ventilated. These new features, spanning across the different levels, are designed to stimulate the resident's senses and encourage constant engagement with one another.

The Kwong Wai Shiu Community Care Centre (KWS CCC) at McNair Road was opened in July 2017. Over 500 members have benefited from the various healthcare services and programmes since. Even more elderly will benefit from the second centre that is scheduled to open in 2019 at St George's Lane.

Moving forward, our suite of services is expected to be expanded even further as plans for another new building are already underway and it is expected to be completed by year 2020. Besides a polyclinic, the new block will also house a 128-bed chronic sick unit that will specialise in nursing home care for residents suffering from chronic illness.

The Charity Concert 2018 is organized in collaboration with the Singapore Chinese Orchestra (SCO), as part of our on-going fundraising efforts to engage and improve the lives of our residents and elderly community. I am truly heartened by all the donors' support as it shows how much all of you take it upon ourselves to ensure that we continue to impact the lives of the many needy elderly.

We would also like to specially thank our Guest-of-Honour Mr Heng Swee Keat, Minister for Finance, Ministry of Finance, and our Special Guest, Ms Sim Ann, Senior Minister of State, Ministry of Culture, Community and Youth & Ministry of Communications and Information for joining us tonight amidst their busy schedules. Their presences have been very encouraging to us.

Finally, I would like to take this opportunity to express my gratitude to the Organising Committee for their tireless effort in making this concert a memorable experience for all. Let us continue the KWSH's legacy of serving the community and enriching the lives of our needy elderly.

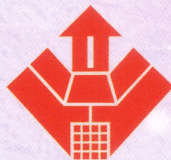
