新加坡华乐团

Singapore Chinese Orchestra

新加坡华乐团是本地的旗舰艺术团体,更是唯一的专业国家级华乐团。自1997年首演以来,拥有超过80名音乐家的新加坡华乐团在肩负起传统文化的传承之际,也以发展和创新为重任。新加坡华乐团赞助人为李显龙总理,并坐落于被列为国家古迹的新加坡大会堂。新加坡华乐团更通过汲取周边国家独特的南洋文化,发展成具多元文化特色的乐团。各种资源和优势相互交融,使新加坡华乐团成长为一支风格独具的优质华乐团。

新加坡华乐团不断策划与制作素质高又多 元性的节目, 使它在华乐界占有一席之地, 而日益扩大的观众群也目睹了华乐团这几 年来的成长。2002年的滨海艺术中心开幕 艺术节上,新加坡华乐团带给观众一部富 于梦幻色彩,又具真实历史事迹的交响幻 想史诗《马可波罗与卜鲁罕公主》, 为乐团 发展史开创新的里程碑。2003年的新加 坡艺术节,新加坡华乐团与本地多元艺术 家陈瑞献一同呈献了别开生面的音乐会 《千年一瞬》,突破了单一艺术呈献的音乐会 形式。2004年新加坡建国39年,新加坡华 乐团召集了2400名表演者,以有史以来最 庞大的华乐队演出《全民共乐》, 堪称壮 举。2005年, 为纪念郑和下西洋600周年, 新加坡华乐团集合多方力量, 邀请多位国 际知名歌唱家同台演出音乐剧史诗《海上 第一人一郑和》。2007年,新加坡华乐团与 新加坡交响乐团,以及本地其他上百位演 奏家组成的联合大乐团, 共同参与了新加 坡国庆庆典演出, 为国庆典礼增添艺术色 彩。2008年新加坡艺术节,新加坡华乐团 与剧艺工作坊合作, 突破性地让莎士比亚 名著与昆曲经典《牡丹亭》在演出《离梦》 中相会。2009年,新加坡华乐团成为历史 上第一支应邀在爱丁堡艺术节开幕星期 演出的华乐团,也并于2010年参与新加坡 艺术节在法国巴黎的演出。

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Singapore Chinese Orchestra (SCO), inaugurated in 1997, is Singapore's only professional national Chinese orchestra. SCO, made up of more than 80 musicians, occupies the Singapore Conference Hall, which is a national monument. With Prime Minister Lee Hsien Loong as its patron, SCO takes on the twin role of preserving traditional arts and culture and establishing its unique identity through the incorporation of Southeast Asian cultural elements in its music.

SCO has impressed a broadening audience with its blockbuster presentations and is fast establishing itself around the world. In 2002, it staged a symphonic fantasy epic Marco Polo and Princess Blue as part of the opening festival of Esplanade -Theatres on the Bay. The following year, SCO produced a musical and visual conversation with Singapore's most eminent multi-disciplinary artist Tan Swie Hian at the Singapore Arts Festival 2003. SCO celebrated Singapore's 30th National Day in 2004 with a spectacular concert – Our People, Our Music – featuring 2,400 local music enthusiasts at the Singapore Indoor Stadium. In 2005, it produced a mega musical production, Admiral of the Seven Seas, as part of the Singapore Arts Festival 2005. In 2007, SCO was part of the 240-strong combined orchestra that performed at the Singapore National Day Parade. In the Singapore Arts Festival 2008, SCO joined hands with Theatreworks to present the ground-breaking production Awaking, which brought together Kunqu opera music and Elizabethan music. In 2009, SCO made history by becoming the first Chinese orchestra to perform in the opening week of the Edinburgh Festival, and in 2010, performed in Paris as part of the Singapour Festivarts.

Well-known for its high performance standards and versatility, SCO has performed at numerous prestigious events such as the World Economic Forum and International Summit of Arts Council in 2003, and the 2006 International Monetary Fund (IMF) Annual Meeting.

SCO has toured various countries and cities including Beijing, Shanghai, Xiamen, Nanjing, Suzhou, Macau, Hungary and England. Recently in May 2014, SCO performed at the Shanghai Spring International Music Festival and in Suzhou to celebrate the Singapore-Suzhou Industrial Park's 20th anniversary. In

新加坡华乐团以高演奏水平, 受邀到全 球各地多个重要场合中演出,包括中国北 京、上海、南京、苏州、澳门、匈牙利和 伦敦。在2014年,新加坡华乐团参与上海 之春国际音乐节以及苏州欢庆新中苏州 工业园区20周年的演出。在2015年,新加 坡华乐团也赴香港荃湾大会堂演奏厅和 香港文化中心音乐厅演出两场音乐会。为 庆祝新马建交50周年,新加坡华乐团参与 了新加坡文化、社区及青年部于吉隆坡 举行的"文化之桥"新加坡文化交流季, 在吉隆坡呈献马来西亚首演音乐会 《乐飘双峰·荟音乐融》, 带领马来西亚 的观众踏上新马文化交流的音乐之旅。 这些海外音乐会不仅大大提升了新加坡 华乐团在国际音乐界的名声, 也奠定了 它在华乐界的领导地位。

新加坡华乐团以"人民乐团"为宗旨,通过 社区音乐会、学校艺术教育计划、户外音 乐会等活动来推广华乐, 为使其他种族的 朋友也能欣然地欣赏华乐。新加坡华乐团 也委约作品,于不同音乐会中首演新作品。 新加坡华乐团主办了三届的国际华乐作曲 大赛, 分别于2006年, 2011年及2015年。此大 赛注入了"南洋"元素,借此创立本地独 有的音乐风格。新加坡华乐团也于2012年主 办了新加坡首次为期23天的全国华乐马拉 松。31支本地华乐团体在新加坡各地呈献 44场演出, 吸引了约两万名观众。2014年 6月28日,新加坡华乐团在国家体育场,新 加坡体育城缔造了历史性的成就,以4,557 名表演者打破两项健力士世界纪录和三项 新加坡大全记录。新加坡华乐团通过启发、 推动、影响和教育的方式来传达音乐理念, 让优雅华乐举世共赏。



October 2015, SCO performed two concerts in Hong Kong at the Tsuen Wan Town Hall and Hong Kong Cultural Centre. Commissioned by Ministry of Culture, Community and Youth as part of the Titian Budaya Singapore cultural season in Kuala Lumpur, SCO also held its debut concert in Malaysia at the iconic Petronas Twin Towers. These international platforms provided SCO with the opportunities to showcase its talents and music, propelling it to the forefront of the international music arena.

With its vision to be a world-renowned people's orchestra, SCO widens its outreach by performing regularly at various national parks, communities and schools. SCO also commissions its own compositions and organised the Singapore International Competition for Chinese Orchestral Composition (SICCOC) in 2006, 2011 and 2015 respectively. The competition aims to promote compositions that incorporate music elements from Southeast Asia, also known as "Nanyang music".

In 2012, SCO organised Singapore's first 23-day National Chinese Orchestra Marathon, a spectacular feat that drew the participation of 31 local Chinese orchestras which participated with over 44 performances and an audience of 20,000. On 28 June 2014, SCO created history through the second instalment of *Our People Our Music* by creating two Guinness World Records and three Singapore Book of Records with 4,557 performers at the National Stadium, Singapore Sports Hub. It is with this vision that SCO continues to inspire, influence, educate and communicate through its music.

葉聰 – 音乐总监 Tsung Yeh – Music Director



葉聰于2002年1月应邀出任新加坡华乐团的音乐总监。在他的领导下,新加坡华乐团迅速拓展其演奏曲目。由他策划的大型音乐会包括交响幻想史诗《马可波罗与卜鲁罕公主》、《千年一瞬——与陈瑞献的音乐对话》、《大唐风华》、《雷雨》及《海上第一人——郑和》等。同时,在《离梦》中把汤显祖及莎士比亚名著融为一炉的初步概念也来自他的构思。这些成功的制作不但广受好评,也把华乐艺术推向了更高的层次。葉聰于2013年10月荣获文化界最高荣誉的"新加坡文化奖"。他也现任为新加坡青年华乐团顾问。

2007年,葉聰担任新加坡国庆典礼的音乐总监,他为这个举国欢腾的庆典节目作了全新的音乐设计。在国家领袖、27,000名热情观众和上百万名透过现场直播观礼的国人面前,葉聰成功指挥了一个由新加坡华乐团、新加坡交响乐团、马来和印度乐队、南音小组及合唱团所组成的联合乐团。在2004和2014年,葉聰也分别在新加坡室内体育馆和新加坡体育城的国家体育场策划和指挥两场千人大型乐团的音乐会。2014年的4,557演奏家的音乐会破了两项健力士世界记录和三项新加坡记录。

葉聰带领新加坡华乐团走向世界,以他的不断努力和深厚的艺术见解,精心打造出属于乐团自己,融汇中西,富有南洋特色,新加坡华乐团的独特声音。2005年,他带领乐团远赴伦敦、盖茨黑德,以及布达佩斯春季艺术节,成功指挥了一系团在他的领导下,展开了中国巡演之旅,先后在北京国际音乐节、广州星海音乐厅、中山市文化艺术中心和深圳音乐厅中成功演出。2009年8月,乐团成为历史上第一支应邀在爱丁堡艺术节开幕周演出的华乐团。

葉聰自1988年至2016年担任美国南湾交响 乐团音乐总监。1995年,他与南湾交响乐 团更获颁美国作曲家、作家及出版商协会 Tsung Yeh joined the Singapore Chinese Orchestra (SCO) as Music Director in January 2002. Under his direction, SCO expanded its repertoire with innovative works such as Marco Polo and Princess Blue — A Symphonic Epic, Instant is a Millennium – A Musical Conversation with Tan Swie Hian, The Grandeur of Tang, Thunderstorm, Admiral of the Seven Seas and Awaking. In Awaking, he melded Shakespeare and Tang Xianzu's plays into one, elevating Chinese orchestral music to a higher level. In 2013, Tsung Yeh was awarded the Cultural Medallion, the highest accolade in the arts. He is also the advisor to the Singapore Youth Chinese Orchestra.

As Music Director of Singapore's National Day Parade 2007, Tsung Yeh conceptualised a symphonic music structure with supreme, textured virtuosity that incensed the national pride in the air. 240 musicians from the SCO, Singapore Symphony Orchestra, Singapore Armed Forces Central Band, Malay and Indian ensemble, Nanyin ensemble and a chorus performed under his baton before an audience of 27,000 and millions of television viewers. In 2004 and 2014, Tsung Yeh directed two mega orchestra concerts at the Singapore Indoor Stadium and National Stadium, Singapore Sports Hub respectively, of which, 2014's concert of 4,557 musicians broke 2 Guinness World Records and 3 Singapore Book of Records.

Tsung Yeh has brought SCO internationally and developed the special artistic identity of SCO through the orchestra's sound and texture, comprising of East and West and Nanyang heritage, which is unique to SCO. In March and April 2005, he led the orchestra on a tour to Europe at Barbican Centre in London, The Sage Gateshead and the Budapest Spring Festival. In October 2007, SCO performed at the Beijing Music Festival, China Shanghai International Arts Festival, Macau International Music Festival, as well as at major concert halls in Guangzhou, Zhongshan and Shenzhen. In August 2009, SCO made history by becoming the first Chinese orchestra to perform in the opening week of the Edinburgh Festival.

Tsung Yeh was the Music Director of the South Bend Symphony Orchestra (SBSO) in the United States from 1988 to 2016. In 1995, he was honoured with the ASCAP Award with the South Bend Symphony Orchestra. Upon his retirement from SBSO, Tsung Yeh was presented the "Sagamore of the Wabash Award" from the Indiana State – the highest honour

大奖荣衔。在2016年5月7日,南弯市市长Pete Buttigieg宣布那天为"Tsung YehDay"(葉聰日)。葉聰也荣获印第安纳州州长Mike Pence颁发的印地安纳州最高平民奖"Sagamore of the Wabash Award"。葉聰现被定为南湾交响乐团协会桂冠指挥。他曾被挑选参加由芝加哥交响乐团主办的"指挥家深造计划",并接受其音乐总监巴伦邦及首席客座指挥布莱兹的指导。他也曾任西北印第安那州交响乐团音乐总监、香港小交响乐团的音乐总监、圣路易交响乐团助理指挥、佛罗里达州管弦乐团驻团指挥、纽约奥尔班尼交响乐团的首席客座指挥。

葉聰曾与北美多个乐团合作, 计有三藩市、塔克逊、纽黑文交响乐、卡尔加里和罗彻斯特管弦乐团等。1991年4月, 他临时代替抱恙的巴伦邦登上指挥台, 成功领导芝加哥交响乐团的3场演出。他也经常应邀担任亚洲多个乐团的客席指挥, 包括北京、上海、广州、深圳, 香港、台北、东京和横滨的乐团。欧洲方面, 他指挥过巴黎 2e2m合奏团、法国电台管弦乐团、皇家苏格兰国家交响乐团和波兰、俄罗斯及捷克的乐团等。他曾同雨果、Delos与Naxos等公司合作录制了多张音乐光碟专辑。

葉聰在指挥教育界亦极富盛誉。他曾是捷克交响乐指挥工作坊的艺术总监,并曾在美国"指挥家联盟"与北美交响乐团联合会举办的工作坊担任讲师。他也曾到北京、上海、香港、台湾和新加坡多次举办指挥大师班。他近年来的新任命,包括中央民族乐团首席客座指挥、江苏大剧院艺术委员会委员和上海音乐学院贺绿汀中国音乐高等研究院学术委员。

given by the Indiana Governor, Mike Pence. 7 May 2016 was proclaimed "Tsung Yeh Day" by the Mayor of the South Bend City, Pete Buttigieg. Tsung Yeh is presently designated as the Conductor Laureate by the South Bend Symphony Orchestra Association.

As part of the Conductors' Mentor Programme sponsored by the Chicago Symphony Orchestra, he worked with Music Director Daniel Barenboim and Principal Guest Conductor Pierre Boulez. Tsung Yeh was formerly the Music Director of the Northwest Indiana Symphony Orchestra and Hong Kong Sinfonietta, and the Exxon/Arts Endowment Conductor of the Saint Louis Symphony Orchestra. He served as Resident Conductor of Florida Orchestra and was the Principal Guest Conductor of Albany Symphony Orchestra of New York.

Tsung Yeh has collaborated with reputable international orchestras including Chicago, San Francisco, Minnesota, Tucson and New Haven Symphony Orchestra; Radio France, Calgary and Rochester Philharmonic Orchestra; and orchestras in Beijing, Shanghai, Guangzhou, Shenzhen, Hong Kong, Taipei, Tokyo and Yokohama. He has also conducted orchestras in Poland, Russia and the Czech Republic. As a recording artist, Tsung Yeh has made various recordings under the HUGO, Delos and Naxos labels.

Tsung Yeh is a distinguished professor at the China Conservatory of Music and guest professor at the Shanghai Conservatory of Music. He has taught conducting workshops hosted by the Conductors Guild, The League of American Orchestras and the Musik Hochschule of Zurich and is also active in conducting masterclasses in Beijing, Shanghai, Hong Kong, Taiwan and Singapore. His new appointments in recent years include the Principal Guest Conductor of the China National Traditional Orchestra, Artistic Committee Member of the Jiangsu Centre for the Performing Arts and Senior Researcher of the He Luting Chinese Music Research Institute of the Shanghai Conservatory of Music.



约夏·贝尔 – 小提琴 Joshua Bell – Violin



约夏·贝尔为独奏家、室内音乐家、录音艺术家和指挥家的职业生涯跨越了30余年,是今日最著名的小提琴家之一。他是索尼古典唱片公司的独家艺人,已录制40多张专辑,并获得格莱美奖、水星奖、留声机奖与克拉西克奖。他于2011年任命为圣马丁室内乐团(Academy of St Martin in the Fields)的音乐总监,是内维尔·马里纳爵士于1958年创团以来,唯一担任其职位的人。

贝尔2018年秋季的演出包括国家家交响乐团与贾南德雷亚·诺塞达,及辛辛那提交响乐团与路易·郎格叶同台演出的音乐季开幕音乐会,以及与梵志登指挥的香港爱乐乐团、克里斯蒂安·马切拉如与巴尔的摩交响乐团、德意志交响乐团、苏黎世音乐厅管弦乐团和斯德哥尔皇家爱乐乐团的演出。本季的主要亮点是与纽约爱乐乐团合演的特别现场电影音乐会,该演出将呈献荣获1998年奥斯卡奖的最佳电影配乐,以纪念电影《红色小提琴》放映20周年。

演出季节间, 贝尔与圣马丁室内乐团继续 在全球巡回演出,并与钢琴演奏家山姆: 海伍德 (Sam Haywood) 在北美和欧洲 举办独奏会。本季的亮点是贝尔与长期 朋友钢琴家杰雷米·登克和大提琴手史 蒂芬·依瑟利斯的首次合作, 他们将走遍 北美的10个城市巡演,包括纽约市的林肯 中心。2019年春季,他与众多乐团合作演 出,其中包括克里斯托夫·艾森巴赫执棒 的捷克爱乐乐团、贾南德雷亚·诺塞达指 挥下的以色列爱乐乐团、与安德鲁·曼泽 合演的萨尔茨堡室内乐团和由曼弗雷德· 霍内克指挥的匹兹堡交响乐团。除此之外, 他将于慕尼黑爱乐乐团、圣塞西莉娅乐团、 西雅图交响乐团(节目也包括儿童电影《 演奏小提琴的人》音乐会)以及与休斯顿 交响乐团的演出兼指挥等。

With a career spanning more than 30 years as a soloist, chamber musician, recording artist and conductor, Joshua Bell is one of the most celebrated violinists today. An exclusive Sony Classical artist, Bell has recorded more than 40 albums garnering Grammy, Mercury, Gramophone and Echo Klassik awards. Named the Music Director of the Academy of St Martin in the Fields in 2011, he is the only person to hold this post since Sir Neville Marriner formed the orchestra in 1958.

Fall 2018 performances include the season-opening concerts of the National Symphony Orchestra with Gianandrea Noseda and Cincinnati Symphony with Louis Langrée, plus performances with the Hong Kong Philharmonic under Jaap van Zweden, Baltimore Symphony with Cristian Mãcelaru, Deutsches Symphonie-Orchester, Tonhalle Orchester Zürich and Stockholm Philharmonic. A key highlight is the special live film concert with the New York Philharmonic of the 1998 Academy Awardwinning film score for *The Red Violin* in commemoration of the film's 20th anniversary.

During the season, Bell continues his worldwide tours with the Academy of St Martin in the Fields and his North American and European recital tours with pianist Sam Haywood. A highlight of the season will be a first-ever tour with his longtime friends, pianist Jeremy Denk and cellist Steven Isserlis to 10 cities in North America including New York at Lincoln Center. Spring 2019 sees him performing with the Czech Philharmonic under Christoph Eschenbach, Israel Philharmonic under Gianandrea Noseda, Camerata Salzburg with Andrew Manze, Pittsburgh Symphony under Manfred Honeck, plus Munich Philharmonic, Santa Cecilia Orchestra, Seattle Symphony – including *The Man with the Violin* children's film concert – and a play/conduct with the Houston Symphony.

Recently released is Bell's recording with the Academy of St Martin in the Fields of Bruch's Scottish Fantasy and G Minor Concerto. His previous release was the Joshua Bell Classical Collection, a 14-CD set of Bell's Sony recording highlights from the past 20 years.

贝尔最近与圣马丁室内乐团发行由布鲁赫创作的《苏格兰幻想》和《G小调协奏曲》。在这之前,他发行了《约夏·贝尔经典集》,一套14张CD的光碟,主要收集了其过去20年于索尼唱片公司所录制的音乐集锦。

贝尔最近参与了两个技术项目。他与虚拟乐器采样公司Embertone的合作下,专为制片人、艺术家、工程师和作曲家创造《约夏·贝尔虚拟小提琴》。 他也与索尼公司合作推出了"约夏·贝尔虚拟体验",用户可在SONY PlayStation 4 VR上免费下载体验,360全方位观赏他演奏勃拉姆斯的作品《匈牙利舞第1号》。

儿童插画书《小提琴之舞》在2017出版,回顾了贝尔12岁时的重大时刻,即他当时在斯图尔伯格国际弦乐比赛上犯了错误,以及后来获得第二个机会的心得。该书由Annick Press出版,并由凯西·史订森写作和杜桑·帕彻森克绘画。这是贝尔第二次出现在儿童书籍里。他首次于《拿小提琴的人》出现,该书使用同一位作者和插图画家,在一年前出版,重述的是贝尔十年前在华盛顿特区地铁站里当街头艺人的一个社会实验的小故事。

身为一名艺术倡导者, 贝尔积极参与"音乐教育"和"音乐改变现状"项目, 后者为总统艺术与人文委员会与约翰·肯尼迪表演艺术中心的合作项目。

Bell recently engaged in two tech projects: With Embertone, the virtual instrument sampling company, **the Joshua Bell Virtual Violin** was created for producers, artists, engineers and composers. Bell also teamed up with Sony for the **Joshua Bell VR Experience** featuring Bell performing Brahms' Hungarian Dance No. 1 in full 360-degrees, available for free download on SONY PlayStation 4 VR.

2017 saw the release of the illustrated children's book *The Dance of the Violin*, recalling a seminal moment in Bell's 12-year-old life when, when he made a mistake at the Stulberg International String Competition and what transpired when given a second chance. Published by Annick Press, the book was written by Kathy Stinson and illustrated by Dusan Petricic. This marks Bell's second appearance in a children's book. The first was *The Man with the Violin*, released a year ago by the same author and illustrator, retelling the story of Bell's famous experiment in Washington, D.C.'s Metro station a decade ago.

A dedicated arts advocate, Bell is involved with Education Through Music, and Turnaround Arts, a partnership between The President's Committee on the Arts and the Humanities and the John F. Kennedy Center for the Performing Arts.

中国西北部的黄土高原地占地广阔,是中华文明的摇篮。此地的人民具有乐天,自信的性格。1985年,香港芭蕾舞团委约了谭盾为芭蕾舞"黄土地"作曲。

谭盾在1990年把"黄土地"的舞蹈音乐改编成四乐章的"西北第一组曲"。20余年后, 他又重作改编, 并把曲名改回"黄土地", 这个版本将在今晚演出。此曲的四个乐章反映了居住在黄土百姓的生活面貌, 并融合了该区民族音乐的旋律与元素, 包括"信天游"的演唱风格, 其歌声高亢而悲壮, 充满信心!

我们今晚将听到第一、第三和第四乐章。

The Huangtu Plateau in north-western China is a vast area of dry, arid, yellow earth, much of which washes away into what has become known, because of the sediment it carries with it, the Yellow River. It is the cradle of Chinese civilization and the people of this region have a character which is resounding, upright and confident. In 1985 the Hong Kong Dance Company commissioned a new ballet celebrating the people of this highland region with a score by a young up-and-coming Chinese composer, Tan Dun. The following year *Yellow Earth* was given its premiere in Hong Kong. Tan Dun left China, settled in the US, and began his own journey to becoming one of the most internationally recognised of all Chinese-born composers.

The arrangement he made in 1990 for orchestra of four movements from the *Yellow Earth* – which he titled *Northwest Suite No.1* – became hugely popular in China, and 20 years later he made a further arrangement, which we hear in tonight's concert. The four movements depict various aspects of life among the people who live on the Huangtu Plateau and incorporate various melodies and elements drawn from the folk music of the region, including the folk singing style known as "*Xin Tian You*" ("Wafting Skyward") which is characterized by a robust and confident singing with a certain pained wistfulness.

In this evening's concert we hear the first, third and fourth movements only.

引子与回旋随想曲, 作品 28 Introduction et Rondo Capriccioso, Op. 28 卡米尔·圣桑作曲、潘耀田移植 Composed by Camille Saint-Saëns, adapted by Phoon Yew Tien

来自法国的卡米尔·圣桑是乐坛热爱周游世界的作曲家之一,并多次乘坐法国航线Messageries Maritimes;途径河内与香港,除此之外也可能路过新加坡。他在作品中融入其周游各地时的音乐元素,《引子与回旋随想曲》为其一。但是,这新颖音乐元素取自西班牙,而不是中国或亚洲。它们的加入是为了纪念作曲家帕布罗·德·萨拉萨蒂。

圣桑于1859年与萨拉萨蒂初见。如作曲家所述,当年15岁的小提琴家"如春天般清新与自然,上唇隐约中见到胡须微弱的影子。他邀我为他写一首协奏曲,仿佛此事为世界上最简单的事情。"圣桑立即为其动笔作曲,但四年后,也就是萨拉萨蒂成为世界最著名的小提琴演奏家之时,他决定为他编写一首技艺精湛作品,即《引子与回旋随想曲》。

表面上,此曲看似不是典型的小提琴乐曲。但在它那看似平静和随和的外表下,却隐藏着其颇为讲求独奏家的技术精深。经过一段柔和与抒情的介绍,它便显露小提琴更为抒情的风格,犹如看似悠闲的典型西班牙舞蹈,并任由乐器顿时飙上最高的音符演奏其展露惊人的精湛技艺。

One of music's greatest travellers, the French composer Camille Saint-Saëns, visited China, calling in at Shanghai on one of the many cruises he took on the French shipping line Messageries Maritimes (which also took him to Hanoi, Hong Kong and, quite probably, Singapore as well). He often incorporated musical elements he had picked up during his travels in his own works, and that is certainly the case with his *Introduction et Rondo Capriccioso*. However, the "alien" musical elements to be found here are not from China or Asia, but from Spain, and were included in honour of the work's dedicatee, Pablo de Sarasate.

Saint-Saëns had first met Sarasate in 1859. As the composer recalled, the 15-year-old violinist was "fresh and young as spring itself, the faint shadow of a moustache scarcely visible on his upper lip. As if it were the easiest thing in the world, he had come quite simply to ask me to write a concerto for him". Saint-Saëns immediately set about writing one, but four years later, by which time Sarasate was probably the most famous violin virtuoso in the world, he decided to write him a true virtuoso showpiece, the *Introduction et Rondo Capriccioso*.

On the surface of it, this work is not a typical violin showpiece; yet, under its apparently calm and easy-going exterior lies music as technically demanding for the soloist as anything in the repertoire. After a subdued, lyrical introduction during which the violin's more lyrical character is revealed, comes a deceptively leisurely, typically Spanish dance during which the violin indulges in frequent flights of astonishing virtuosity often ascending to the very highest notes possible from the instrument.

泰伊斯冥想曲 Thaïs: Meditation 儒勒·马斯内作曲、埃里克·沃森移植 Composed by Jules Massenet, adapted by Eric Watson

儒勒·马斯内的一生几乎是在他的故乡法国度过,而大部分时间都在让他在歌剧作曲方面取得声誉的巴黎度过。人们对于音乐的品味早已改变,马斯内的歌剧也随之甚少演出,但是,他的36部歌剧中至少有一首作品有如1894年首次演出一样受欢迎。在《泰伊斯冥想曲》中,独奏小提琴飙升之时,便是美丽及感性的泰伊从她的世俗乐趣生活转移为致力维护宗教"洁净"的阶段。

Jules Massenet spent almost his entire life in his native France, and most of that time was spent in Paris where he achieved considerable fame as an opera composer. While tastes have changed and Massenet's operas are rarely performed today, at least one melody from one of his 36 operas is as popular now as it was when it was first performed in 1894. In *Thaïs: Meditation*, we hear the solo violin soaring to indicate the moment in the opera when the beautiful and sensual Thais converts from her life of earthly pleasures to one devoted to religious purity.

流浪者之歌, 作品 20 Zigeunerweisen (Gypsy Airs), Op. 20 巴布罗·德·萨拉萨蒂作曲、罗伟伦移植 Composed by Pablo de Sarasate, adapted by Law Wai Lun

约夏·贝尔是诸多周游世界的小提琴大师之一。与其他小提琴大师相同的是,他把动听的音乐带给各大洲的观众。第一位是在19世纪初游历世界的小提琴大师尼可罗·帕格尼尼;之后有帕布罗·德·萨拉萨蒂。他的职业生涯辉煌,多次在欧洲、美洲、中亚和远东等地区举办巡回音乐会演奏自己的作品。这些乐曲具有挑战性,显示了萨拉萨蒂的非凡才华。之后,它便成为了小提琴家必演的曲目。爱尔兰剧作家兼音乐评论家乔治·萧伯纳曾写道:"我们有甚多伟大的小提琴作曲家,但萨拉萨蒂是极为少数的小提琴音乐作曲家之一"。

成于1863年的《流浪者之歌》作品20,也许是萨拉萨蒂最为人知的著作之一。完成了这部作品时,他就读于巴黎音乐学院。此曲以三首吉普赛风格的旋律为基础,第一部和第三部分的旋律均为萨拉萨蒂的原创,第二部的主题则格外奇异,由萨拉萨蒂于匈牙利同时代的作曲家艾乐梅尔·森迪梅创作。一旦独奏家开始演奏这三个主题,他就会利用小提琴的各种技术技巧,使其在演奏中得到充分的发挥,包括由左手弹奏的平流音高音和快速的拨弦音符。

Joshua Bell is the latest in a long line of virtuoso violinists who have travelled the world astounding audiences on every continent with the brilliance of their playing. The first was Niccolò Paganini, at the very dawn of the 19th century, and he was succeeded by Pablo Sarasate. He enjoyed a glittering career giving concert tours throughout Europe, America, Central Asia and the Far East, often playing his own compositions. While they were primarily designed as showpieces for his own extraordinary talent, they have gone into the repertory of every major violinist since then. The Irish playwright and music critic, George Bernard Shaw, wrote that "there are many great composers of music for the violin, but Sarasate is one of the few who is a great composer of violin music".

Perhaps his most famous composition is *Zigeunerweisen* ("Gypsy Melodies") written in 1863 whilst he was still a student at the Paris Conservatoire. The work is based around three gypsy-inspired melodies, the first and third are each original melodies by Sarasate himself, while the second, a particularly poignant theme, is by one of Sarasate's Hungarian contemporaries, Elemer Szentirmay. Once the soloist has taken up each of the three themes, he proceeds to put it through a series of ever-increasingly spectacular cadenzas and flourishes, which exploit the full range of the violin's technical tricks, including stratospherically high notes and rapid pizzicato notes played by the left hand.

滇西土风三首 之 第一乐章: 阿佤山 First Movement: A Va Mountain from *Dianxi Folk Tune*s

郭文景 Guo Wen Jing

出生于四川省重庆市的郭文景,是经文化大革命后重新开放的首批北京中央音乐学院学生。除了在纽约短期学习之外,他一直在中国担任中央音乐学院作曲系主任。他的音乐主要歌颂中国及中华人民,并以滇西民间音乐歌颂位于云南西部的地区,也就是我们俗称的滇西。

在今晚的音乐会,我们将听到此曲的第一乐章:《阿佤山》。它歌颂一个居住约40万人在缅甸接壤的地区的佤族人。在他们的部落土地中心附近有阿瓦山,他们根据传统举行各种宗教仪式,以安抚大自然的神灵,做了动物祭祀,树木和河流义被崇拜,其中的仪式包括砍断牛的尾巴和敲打木鼓。

Born in Chongqing in Sichuan province, Guo Wenjing was one of the first intakes of students at the Central Conservatory of Music in Beijing after it reopened following the Cultural Revolution. Apart from a short spell studying in New York, he has remained in China, serving as head of the composition department of the Central Conservatory. His music celebrates China and the Chinese people, and with his *Dianxi Folk Tunes* he celebrates the part of western Yunnan Province often referred to as *Dianxi*.

In tonight's concert we hear the first movement of the work, which celebrates the Va people, an ethnic group of around 400,000, who live in the region bordering on to Myanmar. Near the centre of their tribal lands stands A Va Mountain where, traditionally, they held religious rites to appease the deities of nature. Animal sacrifices were made, trees and rivers worshipped, and ceremonies included cutting the tails off cattle and hitting of wooden drums.

小提琴协奏曲: 梁山伯与祝英台 Violin Concerto: The Butterfly Lovers 何占豪、陈钢作曲、阎惠昌、顾立民改编 Composed by He Zhan Hao, Chen Gang rearranged by Yan Hui Chang, Ku Lap-Man

此曲目以中国传统民间故事《梁山伯与祝英台》为题材, 吸取浙江越剧的曲调为素材创作而成, 并选择了故事中的"草桥结拜"、"英台抗婚"、"坟前化蝶"三个主要情节, 作为奏鸣曲式的呈示部、展开部和再现部。

- (一) 呈示部: 秀美如画的引子之后, 小提琴奏出诗意般的爱情主题。紧接着的不同乐器的对答和活泼的中段, 分别描述梁祝草桥结拜和同窗三载嬉戏游玩的情景。最后的慢板是长亭惜别。
- (二) 展开部: 以小提琴与乐队的两个相互对抗的主题,表现祝英台反抗其父的威逼。凄婉动人的慢板对答奏出梁祝楼台相会的感人场面。随即旋律急转直下,以激越的京剧导板和越剧嚣板,表现祝英台在梁山伯坟前的恸哭。
- (三) 再现部: 雨过天晴, 梁祝二人化成了美丽的蝴蝶, 双双在天上自由飞舞…

Based on the ancient Chinese folk tale of The Butterfly Lovers, this music is adapted from tunes of Yue Opera in Zhejiang Province. The three main sections of the original folk tale tell of the making of sworn brothers at Cao Qiao, Zhu Ying Tai's refusal of an arranged marriage and the reincarnation of lovers as butterflies by their graves. These three sections are presented in the sonata form – exposition, development and recapitulation of the concerto.

The exposition depicts a scene of sunshine and gentle breeze, with the violin entering on a simple and beautiful love theme. An exchange between different instruments represents the friendship between Liang Shan Bo and the male-impersonating Zhu Ying Tai, who eventually become sworn brothers at Cao Qiao. A subsequent lively allegro depicts the three happy years of the "brothers" studying together, while a lento section shows their reluctant parting at a pavilion. In the development section of the work, the orchestra and violin play oppositional themes to express Zhu Ying Tai's bitterness and her strong sentiments in defying a marriage arranged by her father. A lento passage depicts the meeting between the lovers. Thereafter, the mood of the music changes abruptly. A scintillating passage inspired by daoban rhythms from Beijing opera and xiaoban from Yue opera, illustrating Zhu Ying Tai's sad disposition at Liang Shan Bo's grave.

All ends well when the lovers are eventually reincarnated as a pair of butterflies. Together, they flutter into the sky with newfound freedom, while the original love theme on the violin reappears, paying tribute to their everlasting love.
