## 新加坡华乐团

#### SINGAPORE CHINESE ORCHESTRA



新加坡华乐团是本地的旗舰艺术团体,更是唯一的专业国家级华乐团。自1997年首演以来,拥有超过80名音乐家的新加坡华乐团在肩负起传统文化的传承之际,也以发展和创新为重任。新加坡华乐团赞助人为李显龙总理,并坐落于被列为国家古迹的新加坡大会堂。新加坡华乐团更通过汲取周边国家独特的南洋文化,发展成具多元文化特色的乐团。各种资源和优势相互交融,使新加坡华乐团成长为一支风格独具的优质华乐团。

新加坡华乐团不断策划与制作素质高又多元性的节目,使它在华乐界占有一席之地,而日益扩大的观众群也目睹了华乐团这几年来的成长。2009年,新加坡华乐团成为历史上第一支应邀在爱丁堡艺术节开幕星期演出的华乐团,也并于2010年参与新加坡艺术节在法国巴黎的演出。

新加坡华乐团以高演奏水平,受邀到全球各 地多个重要场合中演出,包括中国北京、 上海、南京、苏州、澳门、匈牙利和伦 Singapore Chinese Orchestra (SCO), inaugurated in 1997, is Singapore's only professional national Chinese orchestra. SCO, made up of more than 80 musicians, occupies the Singapore Conference Hall, which is a national monument. With Prime Minister Lee Hsien Loong as its patron, SCO takes on the twin role of preserving traditional arts and culture and establishing its unique identity through the incorporation of Southeast Asian cultural elements in its music.

SCO has impressed a broadening audience with its blockbuster presentations and is fast establishing itself around the world. In 2009, SCO made history by becoming the first Chinese orchestra to perform in the opening week of the Edinburgh Festival, and in 2010, performed in Paris as part of the Singapour Festivarts.

新加坡华乐团以"人民乐团"为宗旨,通过社 区音乐会、学校艺术教育计划、户外音乐会 等活动来推广华乐,为使其他种族的朋友也 能欣然地欣赏华乐。本团也委约作品,于不 同音乐会中首演新作品。新加坡华乐团通过 启发、推动、影响和教育的方式来传达音乐 理念,让优雅华乐举世共赏。 Well-known for its high performance standards and versatility, SCO has toured various countries and cities including Beijing, Shanghai, Xiamen, Nanjing, Suzhou, Macau, Hungary and England. The year 2019 also saw SCO performing in Asia Culture Centre, Gwangju, South Korea and completing the Europe Concert Tour in Berlin (Germany), Prague (Czech Republic), Forli (Italy) and Ioannina (Greece). These international platforms provided SCO with the opportunities to showcase its talents and music, propelling it to the forefront of the international music arena.

With its vision to be a world-renowned people's orchestra, SCO widens its outreach by performing regularly at various national parks, communities and schools. SCO also commissions its own compositions. It is with this vision that SCO continues to inspire, influence, educate and communicate through its music.

## 葉聪一音乐总监 TSUNG YEH - MUSIC DIRECTOR



葉聰于2002年1月应邀出任新加坡华乐团的音乐总监。在他的领导下,新加坡华乐团迅速拓展其演奏曲目。由他策划的大型音乐会包括:交响幻想史诗《马可波罗与卜鲁罕公主》(2002年)、《海上第一人—郑和》(2005年),以及《离梦》(2018年)。这些成功的制作不但广受好评,也把华乐艺术推向了更高的层次。葉聰于2013年10月,荣获文化界最高荣誉的"新加坡文化奖"。

葉聰靠着不懈努力和深厚的艺术见解,精心打造出属于乐团自己,融汇中西,富有南洋特色,新加坡华乐团的独特声音。2007年,葉聰担任新加坡国庆典礼的音乐总监,他为这个举国欢腾的庆典节目作了全新的音乐设计。在国家领袖、27,000名热情观众和上语万名透过现场直播观礼的国人面前,葉聰可乐团、马来和印度乐队、南音小组,以及合唱团所组成的联合乐团。首届的新加坡写向唱团所组成的联合乐团。首届的新加坡与合唱团所组成的联合乐团。首届的新加坡特色的华乐作曲大赛(SICCOC)由葉聰发起,致力为发扬具有南洋地区音乐与新加坡特色的华乐作品,并提高国际音乐界对此类华乐作品的认识。

Maestro Tsung Yeh began his tenure at the Singapore Chinese Orchestra (SCO) as Music Director in 2002. Under his leadership, SCO expanded its repertoire with ground-breaking works such as Marco Polo and Princess Blue — A Symphonic Epic (2002), and Admiral of the Seven Seas (2005) and Awaking (2018). In 2013, Tsung Yeh was awarded the Cultural Medallion; the highest accolade in the arts.

With relentless vigour, Tsung Yeh pioneered and developed SCO's signature Nanyang music style, infusing Southeast Asian elements and heritage into symphonic works. Tsung Yeh put on a grand display of Nanyang music during the National Day Parade 2007, where he conducted an awe-inspiring performance comprised of musicians from SCO, Singapore Symphony Orchestra, Singapore Armed Forces Central Band, Malay, Indian and Nanyin ensembles. The Singapore International Competition for Chinese Orchestral Composition (SICCOC) was initiated by Tsung Yeh, and subsequently supported by Prime Minister Lee Hsien Loong, to act as a platform to educate and establish repertoire of Nanyang and Singapore-inspired music.

Flying the Singapore flag high, Tsung Yeh has led SCO on numerous international concert tours to great acclaim. In March 2005, he led the orchestra on its first tour to Europe at Barbican Centre in London, The Sage Gateshead and the Budapest Spring Festival. History was made when Tsung Yeh led SCO to be the first Chinese orchestra to perform in the Edinburgh Festival. Since then, SCO's international performances have proliferated under Tsung Yeh's guidance, touring China, England, Hong Kong, Macau, Malaysia, and South Korea. In 2019, Tsung Yeh

葉聰在指挥教育界亦极富盛誉。他重返母校,担任上海音乐学院客座教授。他曾在美国"指挥家联盟"与北美交响乐团联合会举办的工作坊担任讲师。他也积极参与在中国、香港、台湾和新加坡举办的大师班。近年来,他受委中国中央民族乐团首席客座指挥、江苏大剧院艺术委员会委员和上海音乐学院贺绿汀中国音乐高等研究院学术委员,以及捷克共和国国际指挥学院教员。2016年,葉聰荣获由中国民族管弦乐学会颁发的"杰出民族管弦乐指挥"称号;以及被委任中国"千人计划"人才之一。

led SCO on a wildly successful concert tour in Europe, showcasing Nanyang music to Berlin, Prague, Forli and Dodoni to standing ovations at every leg of the tour.

Back at his alma mater, Tsung Yeh is a guest professor at the Shanghai Conservatory of Music. He has taught conducting workshops hosted by the Conductors Guild, The League of American Orchestras and the Musik Hochschule of Zurich and is also active in conducting masterclasses in China, Hong Kong, Taiwan and Singapore. In recent years, he was appointed the Principal Guest Conductor of the China Central Chinese Orchestra, Artistic Committee Member of the Jiangsu Centre for the Performing Arts and Senior Researcher of the He Luting Chinese Music Research Institute of the Shanghai Conservatory of Music and a member of the Faculty of the International Conducting Institute (ICI) in Czech Republic. In 2016, he was selected as one of ten outstanding conductors by the China Nationalities Orchestra Society. In the same year, Tsung Yeh was also appointed as the Expert of China Thousand Talents Programme.

## 李岌诚一笛子

Lee Jun Cheng - Dizi

李浚诚,中国音乐学院本科毕业生。他于2018年考入新加坡华乐团,现任笛子演奏家。

2003年开始学习竹笛。2007年师从邹伯强老师学习,2011年师从林信有老师,2012年考入中国音乐学院,师从张维良老师学习至今。2008年参加人民协会青年华乐团;2011年加入新加坡国家青年华乐团;2012年加入华夏民族乐团以及中国竹笛乐团。2017年参加国际第六届中国器乐赛竹笛专业A组特金奖。他曾与David Murphy、Joel Hoffman、福田辉久、西川浩平等多名优秀音乐家合作。

Lee Jun Cheng started playing dizi at the age of 9 when he joined the Chinese Orchestra in his primary school. At the age of 13, he began learning under the tutelage of Zou Bo Qiang. He joined the People's Association Youth Chinese Orchestra in 2008 and the Singapore National Youth Chinese Orchestra (SNYCO) in 2011. At SNYCO, he was under the tutelage of Singapore Chinese Orchestra dizi musician, Lim Sin Yeo. In 2018, he joined the SCO, and is currently a dizi musician.

In 2012, Jun Cheng was admitted into the China Conservatory of Music, under the tutelage of Professor Zhang Wei Liang. In the same year and the next, he became a musician at the Hua Xia Chinese Orchestra and the Chinese Bamboo Flute Orchestra. In 2017, he participated in the 6th International Chinese Instrumental Competition and attained the highest award given, the Premium Gold Award. In addition, Jun Cheng has worked with renowned musicians, conductors, composers such as David Murphy, Joel Hoffman, Fukuda Teruhisa and Kohei Nishikawa.


## 伍向阳一大鼓

Wu Xiangyang – Dagu

伍向阳原上海青年打击乐演奏家,自小随父学习打击乐和钢琴,毕业于上海音乐学院,师从李民雄教授和薛宝伦教授。曾任江西省歌剧舞剧院和上海歌剧舞剧院打击声部首席,现为新加坡华乐团打击乐演奏家。







Wu Xiangyang was a percussionist from Shanghai, he started learning percussion and piano from his father at a tender age. He graduated from the Shanghai Conservatory of Music under the tutelage of Professor Li Minxiong and Professor Xue Baolun. He served as the percussion sectional principal at the Shanghai and Jiangxi Song and Dance Theatres. Currently, he is a percussionist of Singapore Chinese Orchestra.

In 1992 and 1993, he won the second prize at the International Jiangnan Chinese Orchestra Music Competition and the first prize at the Taiwan Southeast Asia University Students' Composition and Performance categories respectively. He joined the Singapore Chinese Orchestra in 1997. Since then, he has performed in China, Hong Kong, Korea, Taiwan, Malaysia and Europe etc. He is also a percussion instructor at many school's Chinese orchestra.

Benjamin Boo joined the SCO in 2018. He graduated from the Royal College of Music (London) (RCM) with a Masters of Performance (Distinction) in 2016, under the support of the Neville Wathen Award and the tutelage of renowned percussionists including David Hockings, She-e Wu, Matt Perry, and Ralph Salmins.

Benjamin was first exposed to Chinese Percussion at the age of 9 when he joined his primary school's Chinese Orchestra under the baton of his father. A year later, Benjamin began studying Chinese Percussion under current SCO Resident Conductor Quek Ling Kiong. He also picked up Western Percussion with Ngoh Kheng Seng (SCO) from 2004. In 2007, he enrolled in the Nanyang Academy of Fine Arts (NAFA) for Western Percussion on the National Arts Council Georgette-Chen Bursaries Award. Under the tutelage of Mark Suter (Associate Principal, Percussion, Singapore Symphony Orchestra), Benjamin graduated with First Class Honours for his Bachelor of Music (Hons) through the NAFA-RCM joint degree programme in 2014.

## 谭曼曼一胡琴

#### Tan Manman – Huqin

谭曼曼于1989年出生湖南长沙,七岁学习钢琴,九岁随父亲谭小驷学习二胡。2002年考入中国音乐学院附中师从刘虹。2008年考入中国音乐学院师本科师从曹德维教授。在校期间副修了高胡、京胡。2012年毕业并在同年考入新加坡华乐团担任二胡演奏家。

谭曼曼也在由中国文化部举办的中国青年艺术比赛中荣获蒲公英银奖。2010年获得由教育学会,音乐家协会举办的"敦煌杯"首届全国青少年二胡大赛青年专业组A组银奖第一。2011年担任中国音乐学院华夏室内乐团二胡主胡,获得"上海之春国际江南丝竹室内乐大赛"专业组金奖第一。

Tan Manman was born in Hunan Changsha in 1989. She proceeded to learn the piano at the age of 7 and erhu from her father Tan Xiaosi at the age of 9. She was admitted to the Affiliated Secondary School of China Conservatory of Music in 2002 under the tutelage of Liu Hong. She entered the China Conservatory of Music in 2008 under the tutelage of Professor Cao Dewei. She also minored in the gaohu and jinghu while studying at the Conservatory. Tan Manman graduated in 2012 and joined the SCO as an erhu musician in the same year.







She was awarded silver in the China Youth Arts Competition Pugongying (Dandelion) Prize, organized by Ministry of Culture of the People's Republic of China. She achieved the silver prize in the Youth Professional A category of the Dunhuang Cup — First National Youth Erhu Competition organised by the Education Society and Musicians Association in 2010. She was appointed the lead erhu player in the China Conservatory of Music Huaxia Ensemble in 2011, and achieved the gold prize in the Professional Category of the Shanghai International Spring — Jiangnan Sizhu Ensemble Competition.

## 刘智乐一二胡

#### Liu Zhiyue - Erhu

刘智乐2008年加入新加坡华乐团。他毕业于中国音乐学院器乐系二胡专业,师从曹德维。大学期间作为辅修学习过作曲和民族管弦乐队指挥,分别师从权吉浩和黄晓飞。

5岁学习钢琴,10岁师从家父刘尊海学习二胡,并于2001年成功举办过个人独奏音乐会,曾获首届"天华杯"全国专业二胡少年比赛二等奖,2002年获中国青少年艺术大赛第一届民族乐器独奏比赛演奏奖,2007年获第六届中国音乐金钟奖二胡比赛天津赛区金奖也曾录制并出版过音像资料和书籍。2006年担任过北京科技学院"参奥"特殊艺术学院民族乐队客座指挥,并在北京国际"参奥"成果展上演出。

Liu Zhiyue joined the SCO in 2008. He graduated in Instrumental Studies from the China Conservatory of Music, majoring in erhu. During his days in university, he studied composing and Chinese orchestral conducting under the tutelage of Quan Jihao and Huang Xiaofei.

He started learning the piano at the age of 5 and the erhu from his father, Liu Zunhai at the age of 10. In 2001, he won the first "Tianhua Cup" National Professional Erhu Youth Competition and accomplished his solo music concert. In the following year, he won the first Chinese Folk Instrument Solo Competition under China Youth Arts Competition. In 2007, he won the gold award for the 6th China Golden Bell Award, Tianjin zone, erhu division. He has also recorded and published various instrumental CDs and books. In 2006, he was appointed Guest Conductor for the Chinese Folk Orchestra of the "Can Ou" Special Arts College, Beijing Science and Technology Vocational School, and performed for the Beijing National "Can Ou" Achievement Show.





## 曲目介绍

#### PROGRAMME SYNOPSIS

#### 《春节序曲》

SPRING FESTIVAL OVERTURE

李焕之作曲、沈文友移植 Composed by Li Huanzhi, Adapted by Sim Boon Yew

音乐的背景是在中国的一个农村,四处都是庆祝春节的欢乐场面。气氛热闹欢愉,响着民间秧歌舞的音调和节奏。接着是抒情而优美的乐段,富有田园风味。末段是全曲最热闹的部分,展现了一波又一波的欢腾场面,在原有曲调上又加以扩展。原为著名中国作曲家李焕之在1949年为西洋管弦乐而作,此版本是沈文友为《春花齐放2009》委约而移植。

李焕之,原名李昭彩,又名李钟焕,著名作曲家、指挥家、音乐理论家。1938年在鲁迅艺术学院师从冼星海学习作曲指挥。为历任中央音乐学院音乐团团长、中央歌舞团艺术指导、中央民族乐团团长。

The background of this piece is based on a rural village in China, where festive celebrations for the New Year can be seen around the corner. After the resounding music and rhythms of the yangko dance, a lyrical and melodious section follows which is full of pastoral flavour. The final section, which develops from the original melody, is the liveliest, showcasing scenes of jubilation one after another. Originally composed by well-known China composer Li Huanzhi in 1949 for symphony orchestra, this version was re-arranged by Sim Boon Yew for Rhapsodies of Spring 2009.

Li Huanzhi, formerly known as Li Zhao Cai, and also known as Li Zhong Huan, was a famous composer, conductor and music theorist. In 1938, he studied composition and conducting at the Lu Xun Academy of the Arts under the tutelage of Xian Xing Hai. He was the head of orchestra at the Central Conservatory of Music, artistic director of the Central Song and Dance Ensemble, and the head of the Chinese National Orchestra.

《**小放牛》** THE LITTLE COWHERD 刘森改编、张维良编配 Rearranged by Liu Sen, Orchestration by Zhang Weiliang

《小放牛》选自张维良创作的《花泣》, 是一首根据河北民间曲调改编而成的笛子 曲。通过刘森在笛子曲的基础上做出了一 定的调整,更增加乐曲的韵味和表现力。 The Little Cowherd was chosen from one of Zhang Weiliang's composition titled Tears for Flowers. This dizi piece was adapted from Hebei folk tunes. Liu Sen made some adjustments and gave the piece more flavour.



#### 《牛斗房》 BULL BATTLING THE TIGER

王宝灿改编 Rearranged by Wang Baocan

绛州大鼓二重奏,以一个汉族民间传说为依据,主要以牛虎争斗为内容,形象地刻画老虎的凶猛,也颂扬老牛忠厚倔犟、不畏强暴与英勇保护小主人的献身精神。通过"相遇"、"相戏"、"相斗"三个乐段,把牛之倔强刚悍与虎之威武勇猛发挥得淋漓尽致。

王宝灿1962年毕业於山西艺术学院音乐系,同年分配至省影舞剧院工作至今。王宝灿是民族打击乐演奏家、国家一级演奏员。他也曾任山西省歌舞剧院民乐团打击乐声部长,首席打击乐,也是中国音乐家协会会员。

《卧虎藏龙》 选段 CROUCHING TIGER CONCERTO (EXCERPTS) The Jiangzhou dagu (big drum) duet has its roots from a Han folklore, which is based on the battle between a bull and a tiger. It vividly depicts a tiger's ferocity, while praising the loyalty, defiance of suppression and courage of a cow to protect its little master. Through the 3 parts, namely *Encounter, Teasing* and *Duel,* it accurately depicts the toughness and stubbornness of a cow, as well as the might and courage of a tiger.

Wang Baocan graduated from Shanxi Music Academy in 1962 in music studies. Wang is a folk percussionist and a first-class performer. He was also the percussion minister for Shanxi Dance and Theatre Academy, principle of percussion and was also a member of Chinese Musicians' Association.

谭盾作曲 Composed by Tan Dun

谭盾是著名中国作曲家和指挥家。谭盾的音乐被世界最重要的交响乐团、歌剧院、艺术节、电台和电视台广泛演播,对世界乐坛产生了不可磨灭的影响。他的音乐跨越了古典与现代、东方与西方、多媒体与表演艺术的众多界限。

The Crouching Tiger Concerto is based on Tan Dun's Oscar-winning score for Ang Lee's Oscar-winning film "Crouching Tiger, Hidden Dragon". The concerto is in six movements: Crouching Tiger, Hidden Dragon, Through the Bamboo Forest, Silk Road: Encounters, Eternal Vow, To the South, and Farewell. These six movements highly encapsulate the most moving scenes and character emotions from the film. The concerto showcases the timbre of erhu and zhonghu from multiple angles: the interpretation of the theme melody of Crouching Tiger, Hidden Dragon is a melancholic restraint, the exotic colours in Silk Road: Encounters added a sense of mystery for the huqin, in Farewell, it expresses the desolation of life's impermanence profoundly.

Tan Dun is a renowned Chinese composer and conductor. His works are widely performed at orchestras, operas, art festivals, radio stations and on TV all over the world; his influence on the world music scene is undeniable. His music compositions crossed classical and modern, eastern and western, multimedia and performing arts.

三、四十年代的上海,被称为冒险家的乐园,更有东方巴黎的美誉。《老上海》作为《神女》默片音乐会的序曲,以怀旧的方式,表现这座昔日纸醉金迷的大都会繁华耀眼的景象以及电影事业蓬勃发展的盛况。乐曲于滨海艺术中心主办的华艺节2014首演。

罗伟伦出生中国上海,毕业于中央音乐学院。1956年考入中央音乐学院附中,学习钢琴与音乐理论; 因着成绩优异,提前在附中的最后一年开始大学 作曲系的主修课程,师从苏夏;1962年直升大学作曲系,师从中国著名作曲家杜鸣心。2017年,罗伟伦荣获新加坡文化界最高荣誉——新加坡文 化奖。他曾两度出任新加坡华乐团驻团作曲家。

Known as the "Paris of the East", Shanghai garnered a reputation as a paradise for adventurers. Old Shanghai, deliberately nostalgic in style, expresses old-time stuporous and dazzling scenes from this bustling metropolis and the booming film industry. This piece was the overture in SCO silent film concert *The Goddess* and was premiered in Huayi Festival 2014 organized by Esplanade – Theatres on the Bay.

Law Wai Lun was born in Shanghai, China, and graduated from the Central Conservatory of Music. He was accepted into the Affiliated High School of Central Conservatory of Music in 1956 where he studied piano and music theory. Due to his stellar performance, he was allowed to take college-level composing classes under Professor Su Xia in his final year in high school. Law was admitted directly into the university's Department of Music Composition in 1962 where he studied under renowned Chinese composer Du Mingxin. In 2017, he was conferred the Cultural Medallion, which is the most prestigious award an artist can receive in Singapore. Law was appointed as the Composer-in-Residence of the Singapore Chinese Orchestra in 2012 and 2018.

任锦添是一名屡获殊荣的电影制作人。他 经常通过作品勾勒出人文精神,深深地触 动观众,感人肺腑。任锦添在媒体业已经 工作了十多年,全球共有超过 8 亿观众观 看过他的作品。

出世于马来西亚吉隆坡,赵俊毅五岁开始学习钢琴。中学参与民乐团演奏大提琴和倍大提琴。先后在中央音乐学院师从秦文琛、陈钢和唐建平,美国印地安纳大学雅各布音乐学院师从 P.Q. Phan 教授学习作曲、并在2013年获得硕士学位。

Soulmate, commissioned by Singapore Chinese Orchestra and directed by Daniel Yam, for erhu and the Chinese orchestra.

"Soulmate" tells a story about a failed relationship between a father and a son and how their love is reconnected on a Chinese New Year's Eve through music. In the film, the erhu becomes a symbol of dad's love and a hint of the Chinese heritage, leading the conflict evolves into something in sync.

Daniel Yam is an award-winning filmmaker who loves to take his audience on a journey to discover the beauty of humanity. Often heartwarming and sentimental, his works champion the human spirit. Daniel's works are seen by more than 800 million viewers collectively worldwide. He has been in the media industry for more than a decade.

Born in Kuala Lumpur, Malaysia, Chow Jun Yi began studying piano and music theory at the age of five. He gained admission into the Central Conservatory of Music in Beijing in 2005 where he studied with Qin Wenchen, Chen Gang and Tang Jianping. After graduation in 2011, Jun Yi studied at the Indiana University in the US, Jacobs School of Music as a student of P.Q. Phan, and completed his master's degree in May 2013.






